The RCCD district can take out loans and use the reserves in order to make sure we have classes and there will not be a decrease in classes.
- If positions are vacant they will not be filled to avoid Layoffs. This will affect ASNC because we might be asked to provide more to off-sett budget cuts. I anticipate more requests such as the request we have just seen in this meeting.
