Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to June 1985 when the U.S. Navy surplus land near its navy base became the future site of Norco College in "Navy Property."

RCCD became interested in the navy property and toured it at the instigation of RCCD Trustee Dr. Wilfred Airey in early 1983. After viewing the site, the district planned to request Parcel C-2, which was approximately 142 acres, for the development of the campus.

In January 1984 RCCD, in coordination with the U.S. Department of Education, applied for the parcel to the General Services Administration. To strengthen the application, the college solicited resolutions and letters of support from both groups and individuals. It worked.

On June 4, 1985, the 141.86 acres of Navy land was officially conveyed via a quit-claim deed to RCCD.
