Norco College staff readied the campus for its grand opening on March 13, 1991 that included a celebration, ribbon-cutting, and a small number of classes held that day.

Norco College began with a very small staff who multi-tasked to serve about 3,000 students. One of them was Gary Tsubota, a Lab Technician, who came to Norco in April 1991. He recalls the atmosphere to be "family-oriented" and that "everyone knew each other." He said that at the time people did "multiple jobs" because there were less than 20 staff members on campus.

The first staff included Pedro Argumendo, Marilyn Kenney, Ken Andrews, Josephine Carson, and Barbara Woodward to name a few.

Most of the early staff have retired but they will always be a part of the foundation and history of Norco College.
