Educate Your Teachers:

A teacher who simply knows about being LGBTQ can make a world of difference for students who are gender and sexual minorities. Schedule a conference with your teacher or speak at faculty meeting days about LGBTQ issues.

Host an LGBTQ Panel



Gender Grammar

Problem	Correction	Reason
"transgendered" (adjective)	transgender	Only adjectives that are derived from nouns and/or verbs (unlike transgender) end in "ed."
"intersexed"	intersex	Only adjectives that are derived from nouns and/or verbs (unlike intersex) end in "ed."
"transgendered" (verb)	transition	Only verbs can have "ed" added onto the end of the word to become a participle. Transgender is an adjective, not a verb. One does not "transgender," they transition.
"a transgender," "transgenders"	a transgender person, transgender people	Transgender is not a noun. "Jake is a transgender" is not only grammatically incorrect, but can be offensive.
"sex change," "sex reassignment surgery," "gender reassignment surgery"	gender affirming surgery, genital reconstruction surgery, genital reassignment surgery	Surgery does not change one's sex or gender, only genitalia.









KNOW YOUR Trans & Gender

Non-Conforming Youth

The U.S. Department of Education has declared that Title IX's sex discrimination prohibition extends to claims based on gender identity or failure to conform to stereotypes of masculinity or femininity. Title IX also protects against sexual violence. Complaints of discrimination or harassment can be filed for investigation with the Office of Civil Rights.

to an equal education regardless of your gender identity or expression.

YOU HAVE IN BUILD IN not to be harassed, victimized, or bullied because you are transgender or gender nonconforming. School faculty are obligated to take action against harassment, victimization, or bullying.

to wear clothing and hairstyles and present yourself in a way that is consistent with your gender identity, as long as you follow rules for appropriate attire that apply to all students.

YOU HAVE THE REST to privacy concerning your transgender and transition status.

to be free from sexual violence.












