VIII. ASNC Advisor Report

- I know there's a lot of questions right now. K-12 has been canceled for the rest of the year so they won't meet until next year. Nothing is official from Norco College yet, but I'll let you know once I hear anything
- Mark Hartley: I was deemed as essential personnel, so I have been on campus helping students get bags and groceries etc. This is an unprecedented time. If professors are not helping you, or doing their part please let us know so we can take care of it. I do not think that we will be back this semester, it's not official but that's what I think. No official word back from Commencement but I don't think it will physically happen. So, we have some options. We are looking for the possibility of postponing it. But we don't know how long this virus will last. Another option is combining the class of 2020 with the class of 2021, but that might not be possible for all students. We are also thinking about having an online graduation. We are thinking about mailing a package with your cap and gown and other Norco college merch. The last thing that we want to do is cancel this celebration.

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- Edwin: In a report Edwin forwarded to ASNC to get involved with shared governance in Dr. Green's meeting. We should share our student voices in these meetings and there is also a hotspot or a laptop option in that email.
