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IX. ASNC Advisor Report

Discount cards

Edwin Romero: Discount cards will be provided for the students and they will receive an email that will have a link where they will be able to download the app and then have access to the discount card. There is also a pdf that you can download onto your phone instead of having to install the app. It is still possible to find more businesses to add to the discount card.

Michael Moreno: Adding the link of the app onto the email so it would be easier for the students to access the app.

Michael had brought up how some discount codes have already expired so we should get those removed before sending out the email to all the students.

Fee waivers

Edwin Romero: Only 11 students waived their fees compared to last semester, which was 17 students that waived their fees. We are at 90% of enrollment

On Campus

Edwin Romero: Students are not allowed onto campus and are not able to staff booths on campus. Everyone that is on campus needs to be approved by the school president. Students are allowed to get approved to pick up specific items. They specifically did not approve anything that has to do with the Harvest festival. No booths are allowed. No curbside pickup to the public is allowed. We need to be more creative. CSU system as a whole has decided that they are going to be virtual for the rest of the school year including the spring semester. We are more likely going to follow the CSUs and be completely virtual.

Angelica Calderon: Spoke about their constitution and involvement. Concerns about meeting forums and discussing about accommodations in the classroom. Students are concerned about not being accommodated correctly and how professors are dealing with. They are unaware that there are not set zoom times, zoom is not mandatory. Students aren't aware of that so they are trying to figure out ways to overlap classes so they can benefit from it. Discussing bringing on more labs and more courses such as art or music. It is not set on what classes they can and cannot bring in because it needs to get approved.

Tharek Phounsavat: (On class interference) It depends on the professor if lectures are mandatory or not. Send an email to all students about that there are no mandatory lectures then we can take all the classes that we want.

Isaac Nunez: (Avoiding class infliction) They should let you know through Webadvisor. The system should be updated so that we can enroll in overlapping classes. Disclaimer should be made about possible zoom times and if they are mandatory or not.

Marketing Committee

Samia Irfan: Went over the update on the district marketing committee. Went over the style guide. Visual marketing templates for cards. How they cannot use the mascot in certain ways.

Angelica Calderon: Had a meeting with Dr. Green. She is going to have a meeting with all the Vice Presidents and have students come in and give their input. Meeting date and time is not set up. She would like up to 10 students to attend. More than likely going to cover concerns. Further details will be shared.

Reached out to Mark about the grab and go food bags. Using the remaining money from the grant they received. They make about 30 food bags a week. Concern was that they were running out, but they are just testing different ways of distribution. More people on certain days. There is a huge need for food. They plan on retrieving money from their line item. Plan on using \$30,000 or more for housing and the rest (\$10,000) for food. Possible line item next meeting to give more money for food.

Edwin Romero: Some line/budget items are no longer going to be used, may be able to transfer the money over. (Over \$100,000 not being used)
