Resolution 01-2019-20

Support for Measure A: College Improvement Bond

WHEREAS, Measure A will be on the ballot on March 3, 2020, proposing a \$715 million college improvement bond to be voted upon by the RCCD service area,

WHEREAS, if approved by at least 55% of the voters, the funds provided by Measure A would be used to “repair and modernize outdated classrooms, labs, science centers and career training facilities at Moreno Valley College, Norco College and Riverside City College” according to www.rccd.edu/measureA.

WHEREAS, “Norco College recently completed a Facilities Master Plan outlining its specific project and facilities needs. Measure A would enable Norco College to become a comprehensive college, expanding the ranges of classes, degrees and career training courses offered, and completing Phase 1 of a STEM building that provides instructional space for science, technology, engineering and math programs,”

WHEREAS, Norco College students would benefit from the addition of instructional space, particularly science lab classrooms and study space,
