Sen.01.31.01 Approval of up to \$1,500 for STEM Club Rocketry Team from the Conference and Field Trips (92210) line item.

The Associated Students of Norco College will discuss this funding to purchase supplies and equipment related to the development and presentation of a rocket to represent Norco College at a rocketry competition.

 - It took three months for them to receive the supply glue.
 - How much is in this budget? \$7,500
 - Angel: Do you know how much they've spent on this?

 - They could put ASNC on the rocket.
 - What do you guys think about making it to \$2,200.
 - Cesar: Moves to increase the amount to \$2,200.
