- The book scholarship applicants were finalized. About 146 applicants were rewarded and their funds have been disbursed.
- Each of the 3 campuses will be hiring a basics needs coordinator
- SSSCC
 - General Assembly will take place from April 1-3
 - In person attendance costs \$350
 - The room rate is \$164 per night at the Holiday Inn in Downtown Sacramento. The cut off date is March 2nd
 - It will primarily be held in person. Workshops will not be available online.
- On December 6th, Academic Senate met.
 - The ZTC definition was approved, and the creation of an OER subcommittee was proposed.
- On December 7th, the LGBTQIA+ committee met
 - The focus of the meeting was primarily on subcommittees and planning for the Spring semester.
- On December 9th the College Council met. Linsey Grass from the DLR group brought in the information plan to identify ways for environmental, social, and financial sustainability on campus
- The KPI (Key Performance Indicators) Progress Report was shown
 - We are below on many objectives.
 - Low trends are proposed to be due to low enrollment and the current Covid Circumstances.
- On December 16th the Student Support Council met. David Schlanger gave a presentation on identifying areas of need for students.
 - 76% Financial Education
 - 63% Career Development
 - 45% Academic Support/ Tutoring
 - 40% Basic Needs/ Support
 - 17% Employment Resources
 - 13% Transfer Assistance
 - 10% Health Services
 - Student Support Services in Employment was the top requested service, as 277 students requested for help in that area.
