The Associated Students of Norco College will consider approval of subsidizing the cost of graduations gowns for students participating in commencement, on a first come first serve basis, so that the total costs of the students would be \$20 for associates degree recipients and \$15 for certificate recipients, in order to promote participation in the 2022 Commencement Ceremony.
