Academic Senate Committee:

- Bookstore Transition
  - -From Follet to Barnes & Nobles as Bookstore library company for the next 3 years
  - -The transition is currently in process, will be complete by Spring / Jan 2024
- Enrollment
  - -Fall enrollment reached 96% of enrollment target

- -Reached 49% of total year enrollment target
- -Talks of adding accelerated classes to attract students
- -Continued campaign for enrollment
- Liaisons Reports
  - -District Budget Advisory Council (DBAC)
  - -The Kinesiology Building is in the state budget, but will require a district match through a bond.

#### Other

- 1. (Action Item) Senate President Appointments saw an additional amendment: Michael Bobo for Study Abroad.
- 2. (Action Item) Request for Replacement Faculty Process was tabled for a future meeting.
- 3. Standing Committees have not had meeting, most will occur in the 2nd week of September.
- 4. Prison Education saw graduations Aug 7-8 with Pierce College.

#### Course Materials Committee:

- Grant was awarded for \$20k from SB 32 with the purpose/condition of making a fully ZTC/OER pathway.
  - -Looking to turn entrepreneur certificates to associates.
  - -Can work with any programs but the focus is on associate degrees.
  - -Some GEs need to be a part of the program.
- Possibility of hiring/using an existing librarian/administrator to make OER/ZTC materials.
- Professors are given recommended choices for textbooks, but no professor is required to use certain textbooks.
  - -Makes it hard to create an effective ZTC/OER pathway when professors aren't obligated to follow a standard.
  - -Collaboration between multiple fields (like physics interacting with math) is a key strategy to make more successful ZTC/OER pathways.
  - -Changing the book is a minor modification, changing the course description is a major modification that requires district approval.
- Outside contractor considered for OER content (videos, resources...)
  - -Expensive
  - -Not sustainable (one time grant)
  - -Revisions on materials is expensive.
- How can we imbed ZTC/OER curriculum while making it sustainable?

- President: Working on an internship program with Dr. Green, funding for student life desk.
