Senate.10.04.02 Approval to fund \$2000 from Representation Fee (92142) to fund food and promotional items at various non-partisan voter education events for students. Motion Author: Edwin Romero (Action Item)

The Associated Students of Norco College will discuss and vote to approve funding for food and prizes for various events that will prepare students for voting in the upcoming election.

A representation fee is a two-dollar fee that every student pays, amounts to 4,000 dollars, and is sent to Sacramento.

Every college has one representative and they vote on any legislative 12,500 dollars get used to improve representation for the student body state-wide An account is used to create pieces of training and is encouraged, 2,000 dollars is asked to be placed aside for food and voter legislation. (various six-seven events).

Measure CC is voting on whether there should be increased taxes specifically for renovations of buildings.

RCCD has a problem with water on campus and could use some space

30 students are guaranteed in each event due to the guest speakers because of their class where they are given extra credit opportunities.
