3. Discussion Item

3.1 Assessment of Non-Credit, Off-Campus Programs, and Non-Instructional Academic Programs (Honors, CRC, Apprenticeship)

Discussion on the need to and how to assess Non-Credit, Off-Campus Programs, and Non-Instructional Academic Programs.

- Currently Honors is working on developing a certificate with 2-3 program learning outcomes. Goal is to use mapping to assess the Honors PLOs using the honor courses SLOs that are assessed by the faculty teaching the courses.
 - Honors program has flags that can help identify the students in the program.
 - Suggestion to assess retention, completion, success, etc. of the honors program. Problem is on how to obtain the data needed to assess. Suggestion to connect to the Program Review Committee to have Honors added to the dashboards.
- Courses taught at the CRC are the same as courses taught on campus.
 - Why would the CRC need PLOs? PLO's would provide a way of assessing the CRC program.
- How are we handling the assessment of non-credit courses?
 - Suggestion to reach out to Adam Martin.
- ILA-1 has outcomes but has never been assessed. Suggestion to reach-out to Daren Koch and Damon Nance.
- Need to look into how to assist BEIT courses that are taught off campus and do not have access to Nuventive.
- Suggestion to provide support to these programs.

3.2 6-Year Cycle (Fall 2021- Spring 2027)

The current six-year cycle started this semester. We have 6 years to close the loop on our outcomes.

- Clarification that we are not on a pause assessing.
- Request for the committee members to share with departments that assessment should be happening, we are in the first semester of the 6-year cycle.
- SLO mapping to PLO can still be done in the old Nuventive system, until the new system is ready.
- Before each semester Charise updates the SLO using the public CurriQunet site.
- How well is learning accruing during this time of remote learning? We can look into this if assessment is being done now.
- Suggestion to focus on assessing rarely offered courses.

- Student Services is working on the planning phase of the assessment cycle.
- Suggestion for co-chairs to send a Nor-all informing that the assessment cycle has started using the assessment form.

3.3 Leading From the Middle Project Team

The LFM - [Equitable Assessment and Decision-Making Guided Pathways and Equity Charter](#) was shared with the committee.

- How the LFM team was initiated and the purpose, charge and expected deliverables were discussed.
Scope includes:
 - How to obtain disaggregated assessment data.
 - Looking at Canvas and Nuventive integration.
 - Connection between Assessment and Program Review, how to define Units.
 - Currently, what is called a unit in Program Review doesn't clearly align with what is called a unit in Assessment.
- Is the LFM group connected to Guided Pathways?
 - Yes, the LFM group was developed by and is supported by Guided Pathways.
- NAC can expect standing updates from the LFM group.

3.4 Canvas and Nuventive Integration

An update on the status of the integration between Canvas and Nuventive.

- The data fields that would be pulled from Canvas shells and shared with and/or surface in Nuventive was shared with the committee.
- How does faculty feel about this data being shared with Nuventive?
 - Question if only 'assignments' (question from an exam, project, writing assignment, etc.) that are connected to SLOs in the Canvas shell will be pulled into Nuventive. This is the understanding but will clarify with Nuventive.
 - Need to clarify how the disaggregated data will display in Nuventive, at the course level, section level.
- Suggestion to invite someone from Nuventive to give a demonstration at the next NAC meeting.

4. Information Items

4.1 Frequently Used Assessment Methods

The Frequently Used Assessment Methods that have been used the last 7 years in Nuventive was shared (Attached).

- Surprised that 'coursework converted to rubric score' was the least used method.
- 'Exam/ Quiz-Embedded questions tied to SLOs' was the most frequently used method.
- Will be used to create dropdown menu of assessment methods in new assessment units.

4.2 Nuventive Update

A quick update on the status of the assessment units in Nuventive. Progress is being made building the Student Service assessment units. Progress is being made but it has been a slow process.
