The curriculum committee, a sub-committee of the academic senate, has two primary purposes: to review and approve new curriculum including new courses, course modifications, new programs and program modifications,

and to review and approve the curriculum approval process. The college curriculum committee is the sole approving body for Norco College only curriculum. For district shared curriculum it has one vote in the district curriculum committee. The curriculum committee is also responsible for keeping abreast with state mandated curriculum changes and reporting those changes to faculty. Committee members report on curriculum at their department meetings and solicit suggestions and recommendations when needed.



TOP2CIP information applied to ADTs and Common Course Numbered Templates - August 24, 2026

Preface

This document replaces the informational email of April 2, 2026, from Dean Raul Arambula. This document is TOP2CIP information applied to Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) and Common Course Numbering (CCN) templates. The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (Chancellor's Office) collaborated with the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges (ASCCC) representatives to identify CIP codes for existing Transfer Model Curricula (TMCs) and CCN Templates. Identical CIP codes for all colleges will apply to the corresponding ADTs and CCN Templates and will be uploaded directly into COCI; no college action is required.

CIP selection prioritized outcome alignment, the educational scope of an associate degree, and the presence or absence of existing specificity within Taxonomy of Programs (TOP) codes, rather than relying exclusively on within-discipline specificity. It is important to clarify that CIP codes are used for reporting and classification purposes.

The process for CIP selection using the 2026 TOP to CIP crosswalk was as follows:

- For ADTs, the group reviewed the existing ADT TOP codes and selected the corresponding CIP code that is most generally applied.
- For CCN Templates, the group reviewed the TOP codes that colleges are currently using. Based on that information, the codes were checked against the current crosswalk to determine the best fit, and the corresponding CIP code that is most generally applied was selected. Efforts were made to retain CTE status across TOP and CIP codes where applicable.

CIP codes do not determine Minimum Qualifications or local discipline assignment under Title 5 or the Program and Course Approval Handbook.

ADT Templates

- Under TOP, Child Development and Early Childhood Education (ECE) shared a single CTE TOP code (1305.00). As we've worked through the CIP transition, we've taken a close look at the national CIP structure and found that the two disciplines are treated differently. In CIP, Child Development falls within the

Human Sciences/Family and Consumer Sciences (19.xxxx) family and is not designated as CTE. Early Childhood Education falls within the Education (13.xxxx) family and is designated as CTE.

- To stay aligned with the national CIP structure, we will be separating the two. That means Child Development will no longer be considered CTE, while Early Childhood Education will continue to be CTE. This change reflects the way the national CIP taxonomy organizes academic disciplines—it is not intended to diminish the importance of Child Development or its essential role in preparing the early childhood education workforce.
