Distance Education Committee

The committee advises strategic planning committees on institutional needs and best practices for distance education to best support faculty's ability to teach in an on-line environment and recommends to the college, and the district, requisite tools needed by the faculty to teach effectively in an on-line mode.

Charge

The Distance Education Committee is primarily responsible for assisting faculty in the creation and implementation of well-designed courses that utilize current on-line teaching approaches, and best practices, taking into consideration the wide range of diversity in our student body and ensuring that courses are equity minded and supportive of students' needs.

The committee will engage in the institution's collaborative efforts to close all identified student equity gaps (Goal 3 EMP) in the on-line environment by identifying and

connecting with external, internal, and district resources; providing professional development opportunities; and connecting with established campus resources, sources of support, and the district.
