**I. Meeting began at 10:46am**

**II. Approval of September 23<sup>rd</sup> minutes:** Dr. Nelson motioned to approve and Stan Tyler gave a second motion. Committee approved as submitted.

**III. Action Items: None**

**IV. November Events:**

- a. Sub-committee met in October and brought up Francisco Garcia, an artist who submitted a proposal for a mural project, lecture, and freestyle performance. Committee reviewed resume and proposal. The lecture would be on Native American History, he would also do a performance/open mic session and mural collaboration. (Proposal stated \$3,125.00 with travel fees and supplies, which is over the budget amount proposed for November events.)
- b. Eric Perez brought up the possibility of having Native American dancers on campus. Possibly before Read to Succeed on 11/17/16. Eric contacted dancers from UCR and is waiting for a confirmation. \$300 was the fee for the Native American Dancers and \$300.00 for the Aztec Dancers. The date that was originally thought of was 11/15/16 but there is a Presidential Forum during college hour.
- c. Dr. Nelson brought up the idea of changing the dates to the week of 11/21/16. Monday can be the film festival in which many videos are compiled and viewed. (Dr. Nelson presented a couple of videos to committee that target the "Truth about Thanksgiving". If this takes place Monday evening, professors can possibly make it an assignment and attend instead of a lab. Eva and Dr. Nelson will promote in their classes.
- d. Tuesday 11/22 can be the Aztec and Native American dancers in quad or amphitheater. Mural can begin Tuesday as well. Dr. Ocegüera said Tuesday night can also be some sort of teach-in at 5pm for a lecture. Daniel can check with ASNC to make sure dates are okay. Dr. Ocegüera will check with artist and Eric Perez will check with dancers on new proposed dates. Wednesday can be the ongoing mural project.

- e. BFPC would need to hear about plan and approve. Daniel will work on communicating with Mark to put us on the agenda. Gustavo and Daniel will meet with Mark.
  - f. Nov budget: Possible fry bread makers, dancers, and light refreshments. Dr. Ocegüera will speak with artist about modifying the proposal so that the committee can vote electronically. Next Friday is the ASNC Senate meeting, Eva and Daniel will attend on 11/4/16 to see if ASNC wants to partner on this event.
- V. October Debrief:** Time was an issue and planning needs to take place ahead of time. Quotes from the “wall of dreams” were collected. One of the issues was not hearing back soon enough from speaker and dancers.
- VI. ISPC Report:** Tri-Chairs reported last week, ISPC enjoyed themes and logo. Dr. Dieckmeyer would like some pictures from last year’s Day of Inclusiveness. Bernice will check to see if she has last year’s pictures. Eva mentioned possibly sharing the logo and planned events during the Student Services Retreat.
