II. Approval of March 2017 minutes: Lisa Nelson motioned to approve and Ana-Marie Olaerts gave a second motion. Committee approved as submitted. Approval of Agenda: Patricia Worsham gave a motion and Ana-Marie second.

III. Action Items: New Voting Members

a. Committee went over new members list and new tri-chairs, Jesse Lopez and Bernice Delgado. Faculty tri-chair is TBD; Dr. Lisa Nelson will commit if nobody else is interested. Committee approved members list unanimously.

IV. Discussion Items:

- a. Logo was reviewed and Dr. Nelson went over the committee's history for the new members.
- b. Past events were reviewed by Bernice and Jesse for FY 16-17. Araceli recommends using open spaces for panels so that it brings more attendance and promoting events with faculty members to increase student participation.
- c. Budget, Student Equity office will still provide \$5,000.00 for FY 17-18 and ASNC has a line item for Legacy for \$2,000.00. A total budget of \$7,000.00.
- d. Edwin recommends smaller monthly celebrations to bring awareness and a couple of large events. ASNC will have a calendar of their events that will be posted online so that we can work around it. Committee agreed to have smaller events and possibly one large event per term.
- e. Dr. Nelson mentioned the importance of bringing up conversations on campus. Brady recommends monthly discussions and a couple of large events. Ana-Marie mentioned civil discourse and bringing contemporary issues.
- f. Oct. 11th is National Coming Out Day; t-shirts are being ordered and there is a possibility to hand them out or sell them in October. A discussion panel will take place on Oct. 24th. Brady will communicate with Dr. Jan Muto to come up with an appropriate title.
 - i. Committee watched animation clip, "In a heartbeat"
 - ii. Committee agreed to use #whatsyourstory for the fiscal year.

- iii. Panel should consist of staff, students, all.
- iv. Bernice will follow up on t-shirts to be ready for Oct. 24th
- v. Jesse and Ammanda will take the lead with the panel.
- g. Meeting minutes will be done on a rotation basis. Monique, Edwin, and Bernice will help with minutes.
- h. Future public speaker possibilities; Brady has contacts with Rocky Peter (Speaker/Singer), Adam Rippon (Figure Skater), and Benji Sshwimer (Dancer/Motivational Speaker). He will try to contact one of them for a quote for future events.
- i. Members discussed the possibility of having a training on how to facilitate certain conversations within a class or a group.
- j. Brady volunteered to create social media accounts for the committee and he would like to create flyers for events.
- k. Umoja Panel Discussion will be on 11/21/17, Taking a Knee.
