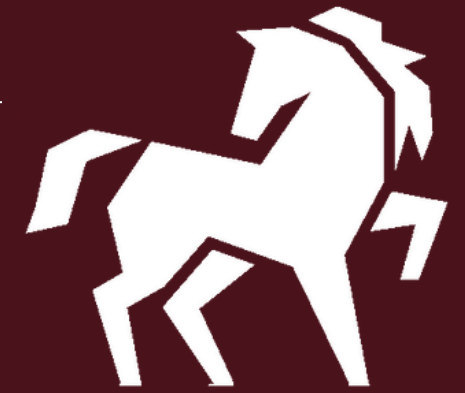


THE QUESTION

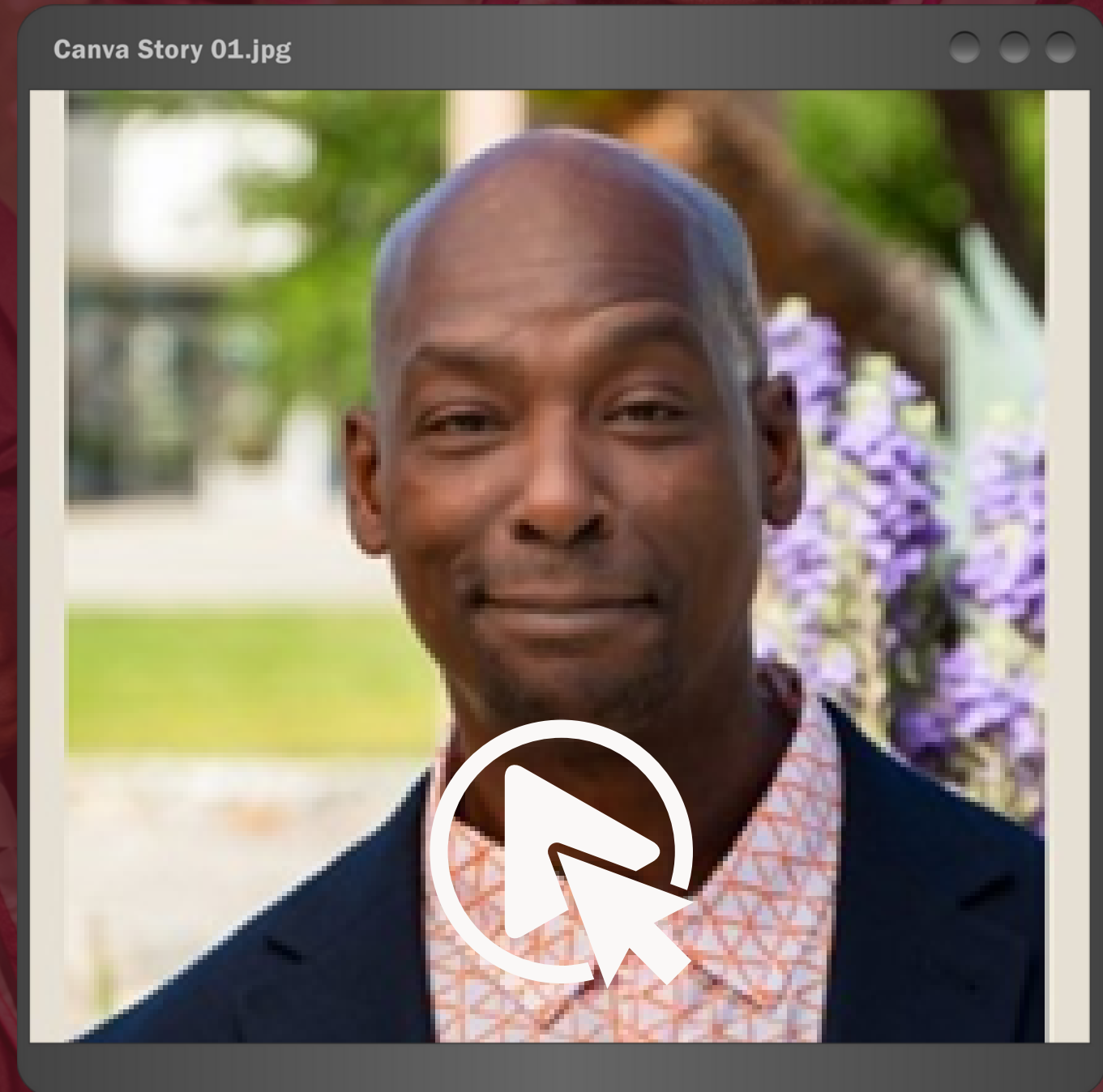

- IDENTIFY WHERE SYSTEMIC RACISM IS AFFECTING OUR BLACK/AA STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES
- PROMOTE INCLUSIVITY AND ELIMINATE ANTI-BLACKNESS IN CLASSROOMS
- CREATE ANTI-RACISM CURRICULUM, AND ELIMINATE ANTI-BLACKNESS
- COMMIT TO ONGOING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AROUND ANTI-RACIST PEDAGOGIES AND STUDENT SUPPORT
- PROMOTE RESTORATIVE JUSTICE FOR OUR BLACK/AA STUDENTS AND COLLEAGUES

- COMPILE THE HISTORY OF NORCO COLLEGE FOR HISTORY AND LEGACY OF RACISM
- AUDIT HIRING PRACTICES TO ENSURE EQUITY-MINDED PROCESSES AND STRUCTURES LEADING TO HIRING MORE BLACK/AA EMPLOYEES
- COLLECT DISAGGREGATED DATA RELATED TO STUDENT EXPERIENCES WITH DISTRICT AND CAMPUS POLICE TO ASSESS EQUITABLE TREATMENT OF BLACK/AA STUDENTS
- CLARIFY AND SIMPLIFY THE STUDENT GRIEVANCE PROCESS FOR COMPLAINTS REGARDING DISCRIMINATION, HARASSMENT, OR RETALIATION
- DEPLOY TRAINED COMMUNITY ADVOCATES OR OMBUDSMEN TO IMPROVE THE COLLEGE'S RESPONSE TO STUDENT COMPLAINTS
- PROVIDE ONGOING PRO-BLACK PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR ALL CONSTITUENT GROUPS AT THE COLLEGE
