Session Descriptions

Becoming an Equity-Minded Practitioner: With over 16 years of experience within the California Community Colleges in various faculty roles, and currently as Dean of Student Success and Equity at Cuyamaca College, Dr. Jesús Miranda will share highlights of his most recent research and practice within the equity-minded space. His Keynote discussion will focus on the central topics to becoming an equity-minded practitioner and institution within the California Community College. Topics will include perspectives and approaches with racial inequities in student outcomes, identifying the systemic challenges to our equity efforts within the CCC environment, practitioner commitment to effectively address racial inequities (beyond good intentions), and the work within the equity-minded space moving forward in our unique environments.

What's New in the World of NC Assessment?: An update on the new assessment cycle including: cycle overview, Nuventive update, next steps and assessment projects (LFM Team, and NAC Subgroup).

"The homeless crisis in Los Angeles, how can we effect change as educators?": Each night 100s of community college students sleep on the street. How can educators help to mitigate this challenge? Come and let's brainstorm.

Tuition-Free College: Planning for Noncredit in RCCD: Noncredit offers students the opportunity to complete tuition-free courses and certificates, providing pathways to college credit programs and the attainment of meaningful wage work.

This session provides a review of the basics of adult education and noncredit, provides data on potential student populations, summarizes noncredit status in RCCD, and highlights noncredit planning efforts.

In Fall 21, the Racial Justice Taskforce (RJTF) initiated the Sawubona Mosaic Series with the purpose of introducing Black and African American students and college employees to the Norco College community.
