The College Futures foundation grant was awarded to the college in the amount of \$100,000 and spearheaded by Diane Dieckmeyer. The goals of the grant are to support the alignment of existing certificates & degrees, including associates degrees for transfer. The grant will also support both new and existing students at Norco by increasing their awareness of meta majors and will support the planning and implementation of the guided pathways work. Lastly, the grant will support linkages between degree programs of study and career opportunities available to graduations. Two disbursements of \$50,000 will be made; one on December 9, 2016, and the other on June 9, 2017. The report out schedule for providing progress will be January 31, 2018.
