3.3 Assessment (Hayley Ashby)

- The College is moving towards reporting assessment results in Canvas through the gradebook, with the potential to use Nuventive on the dashboard. Hayley and Vivian were able to explore this resource while participating in a pilot group over the summer.
- Hayley is working on completing the Chancellor's Office Annual Library Data Survey.
- Hayley provided an annual report of statistics for the Library and the LRC for fall-to-fall comparison. Overall, we are seeing students return to campus. Hayley is working on a semester snapshot infographic to show spring 2022 so it can be distributed broadly and shared with the Academic Senate.

 - Calculation method: Decaying average: This method weighs the final assessment at 60% and all prior assessments are averaged and weighed at 40%.
