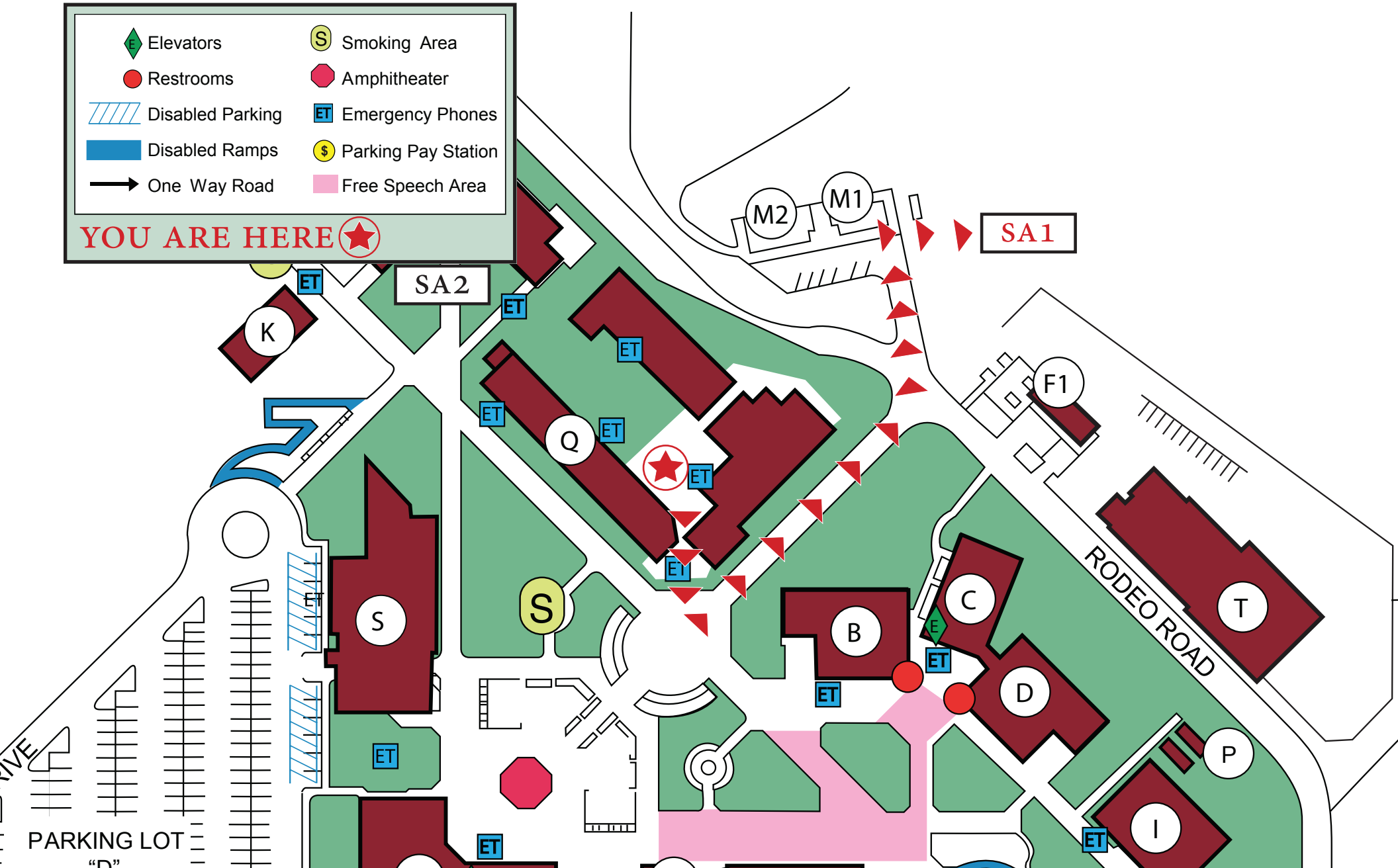

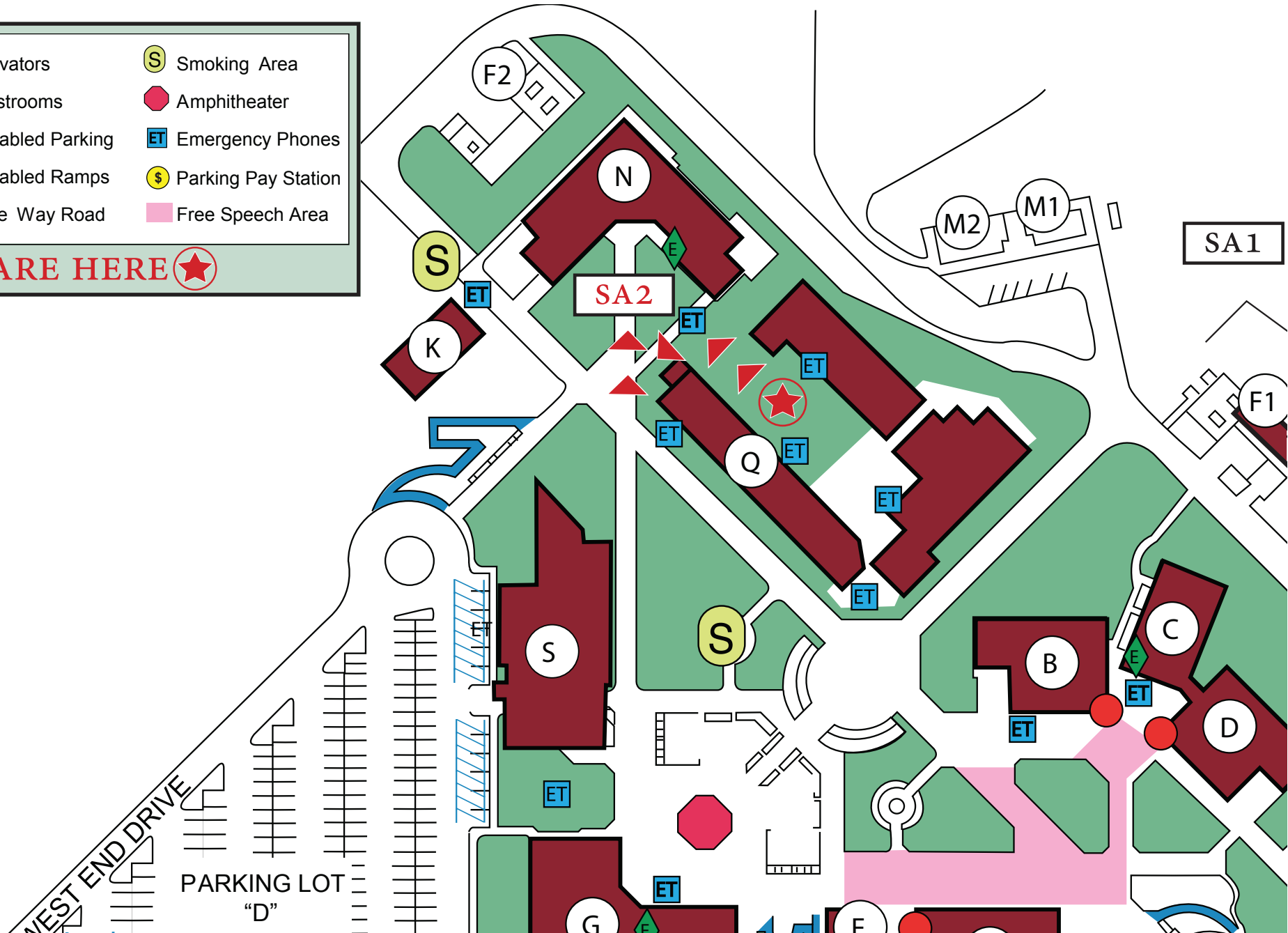


INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY (IT) EVACUATION MAP

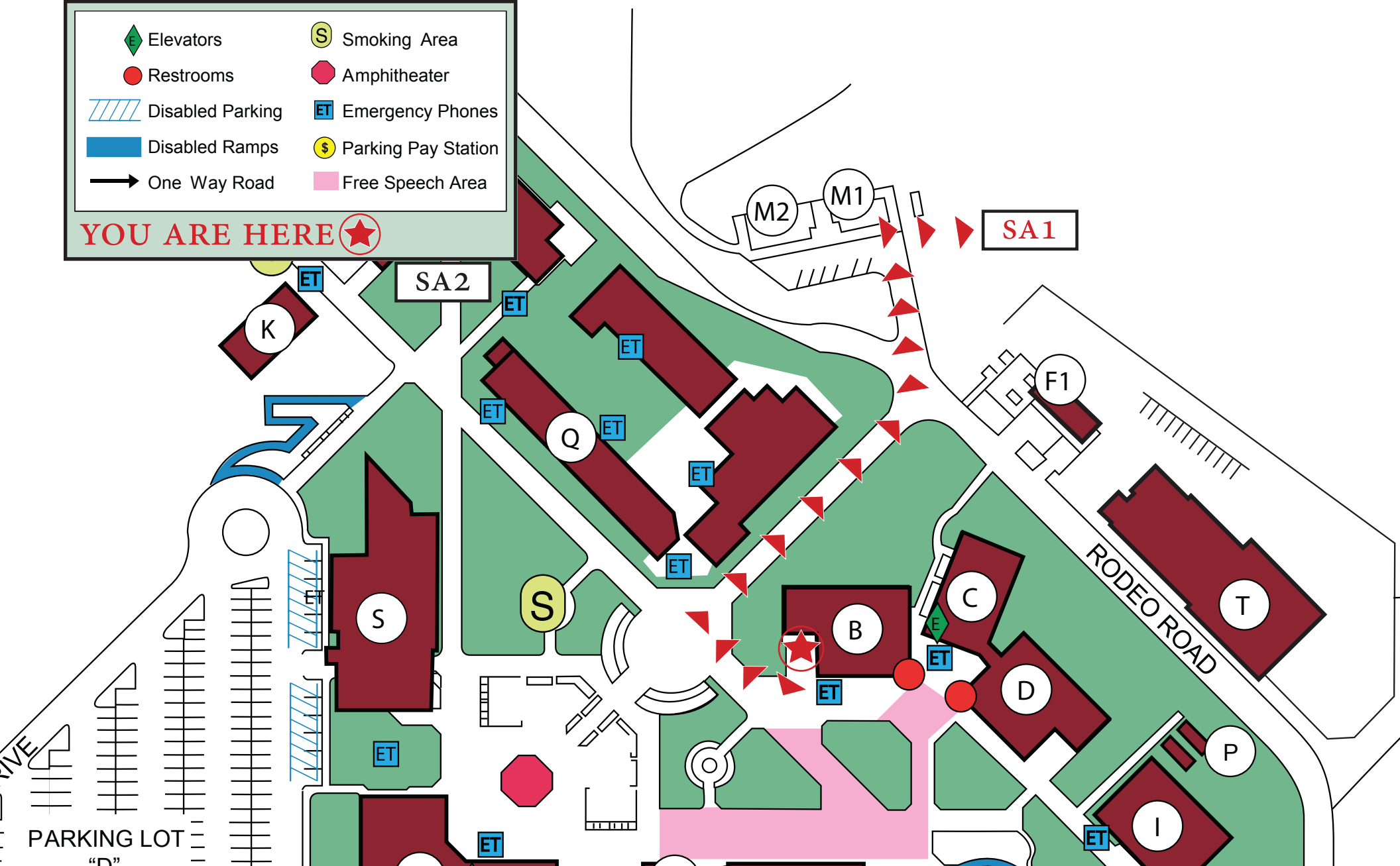


SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (ST) EVACUATION MAP

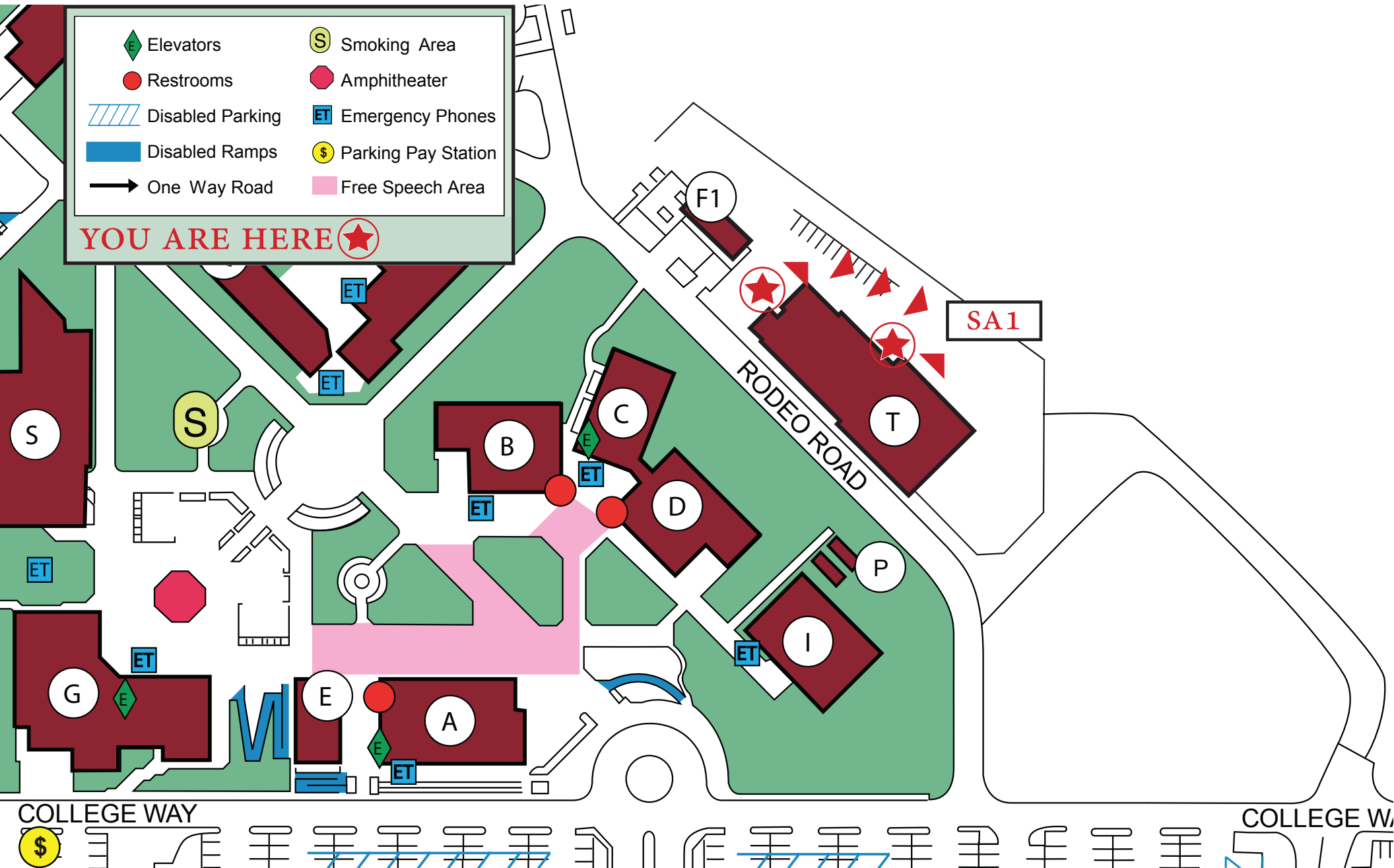

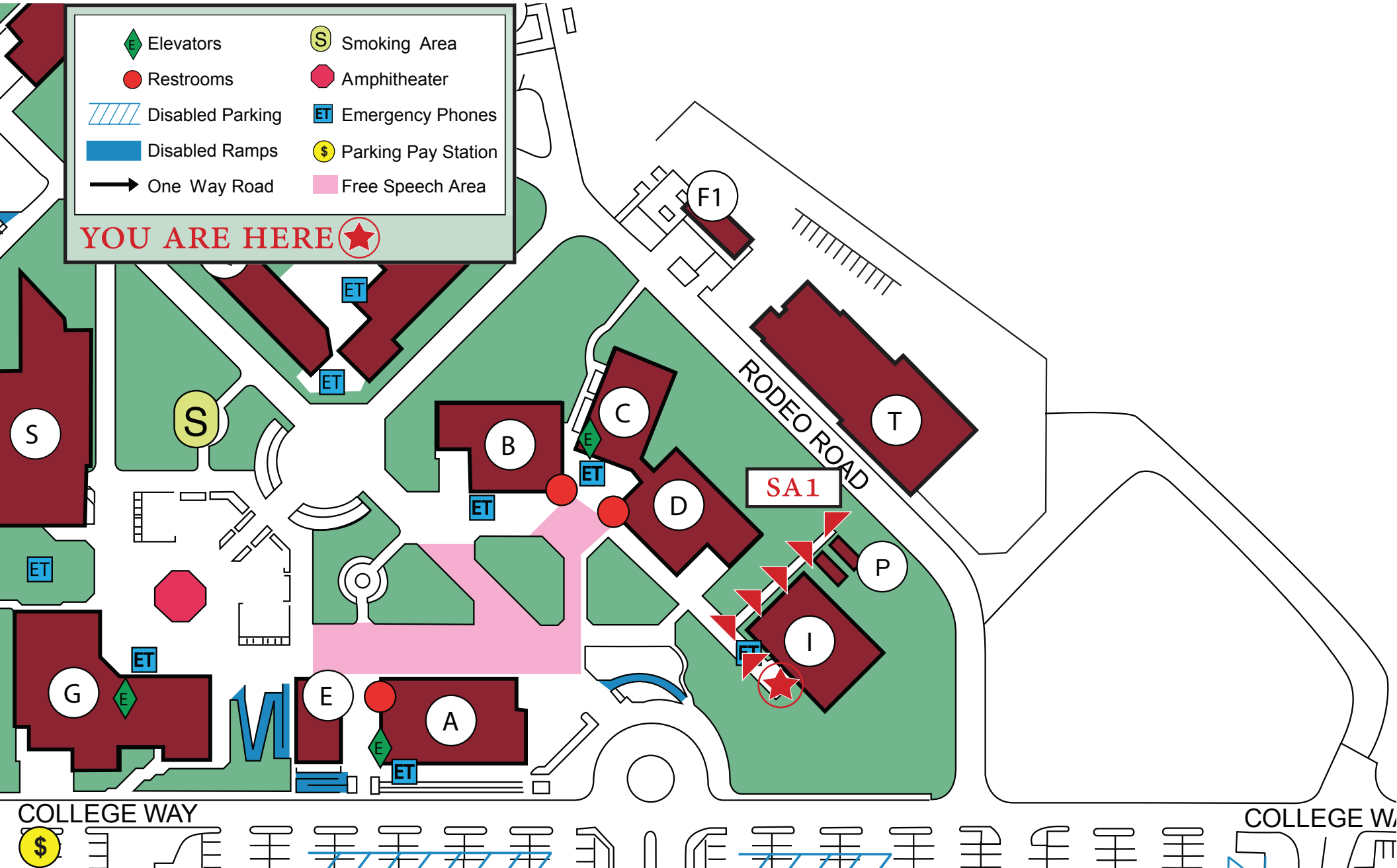
OPERATIONS CENTER EVACUATION MAP

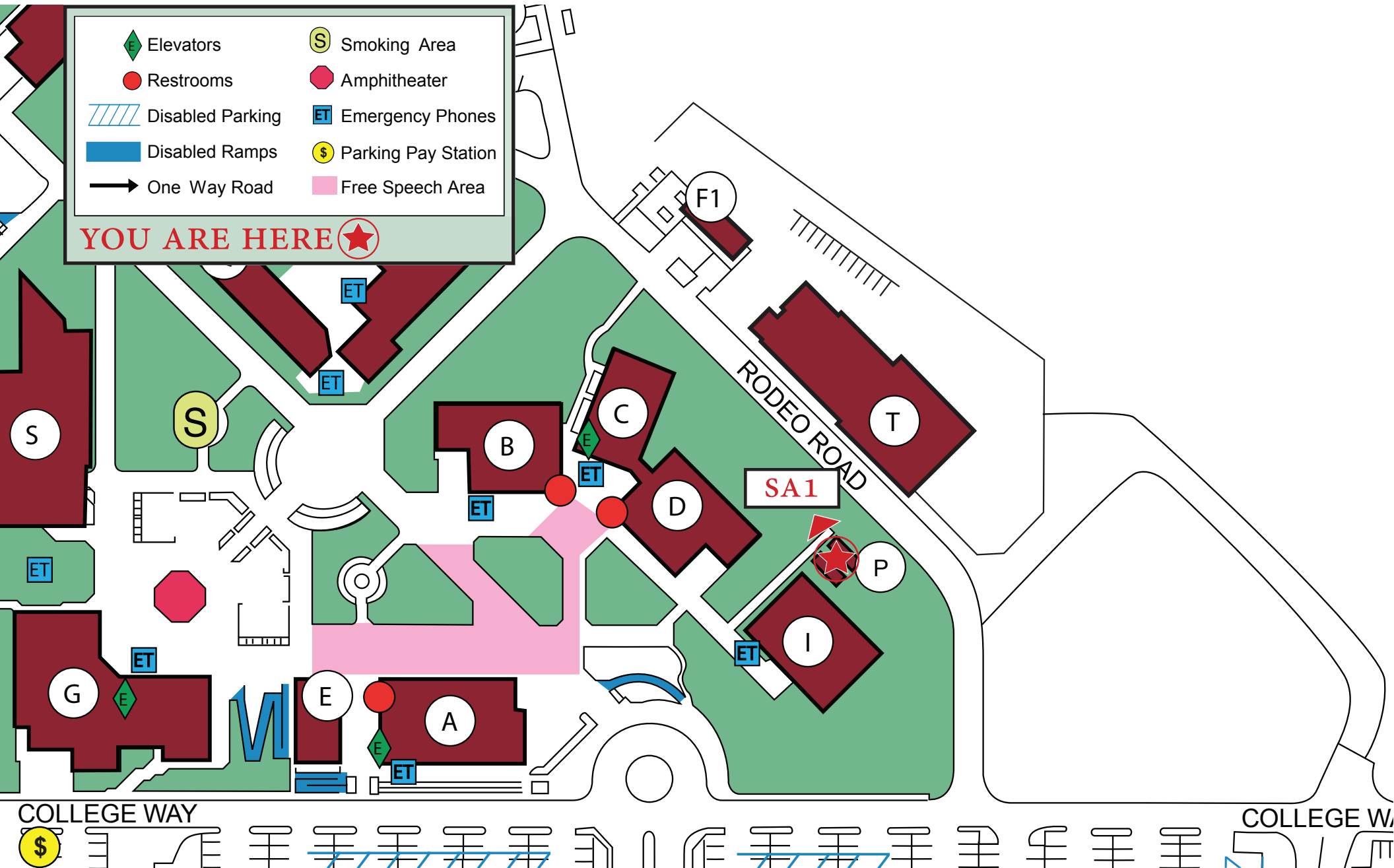
BOOKSTORE EVACUATION MAP

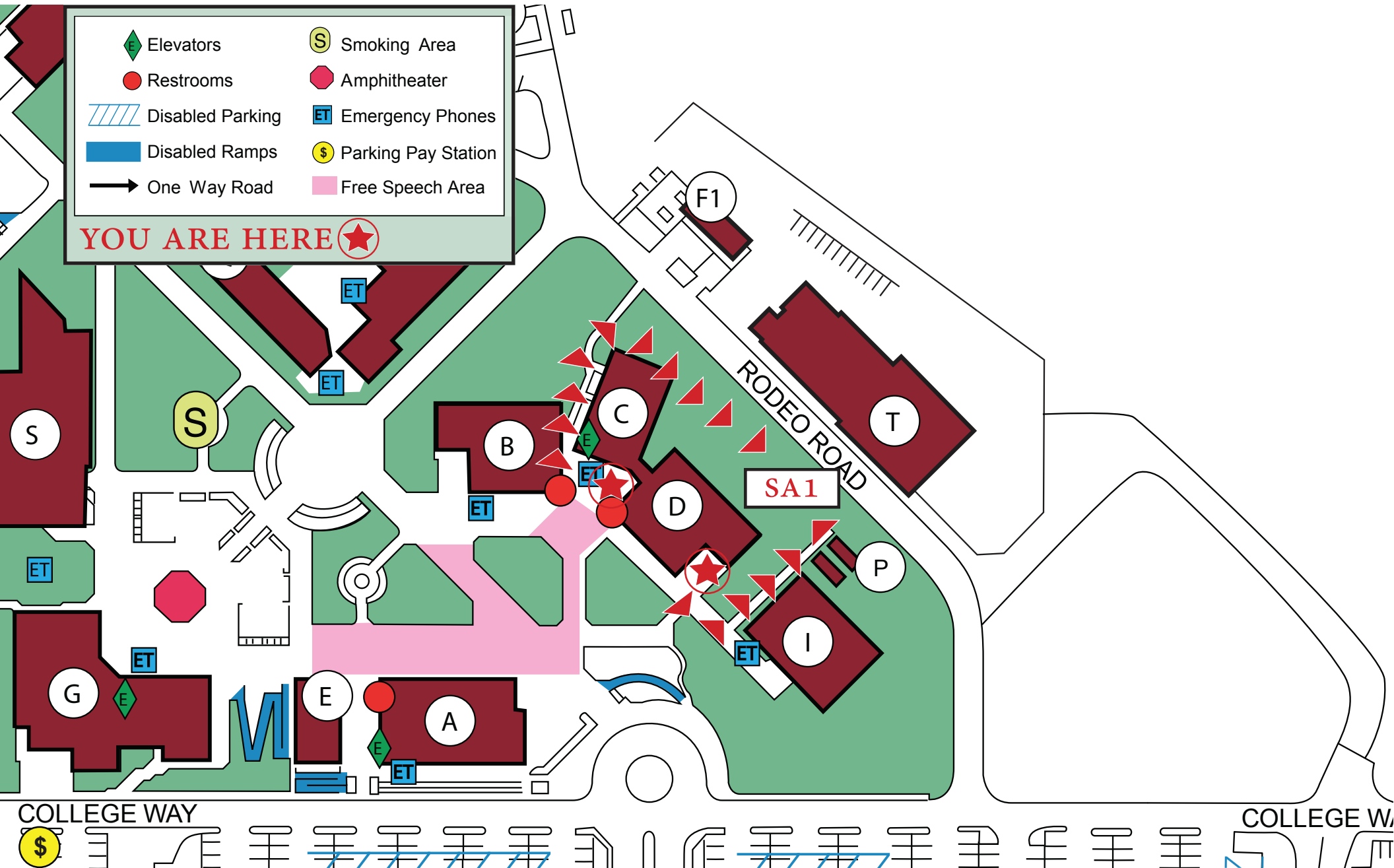
PORTABLES (A | B) EVACUATION MAP

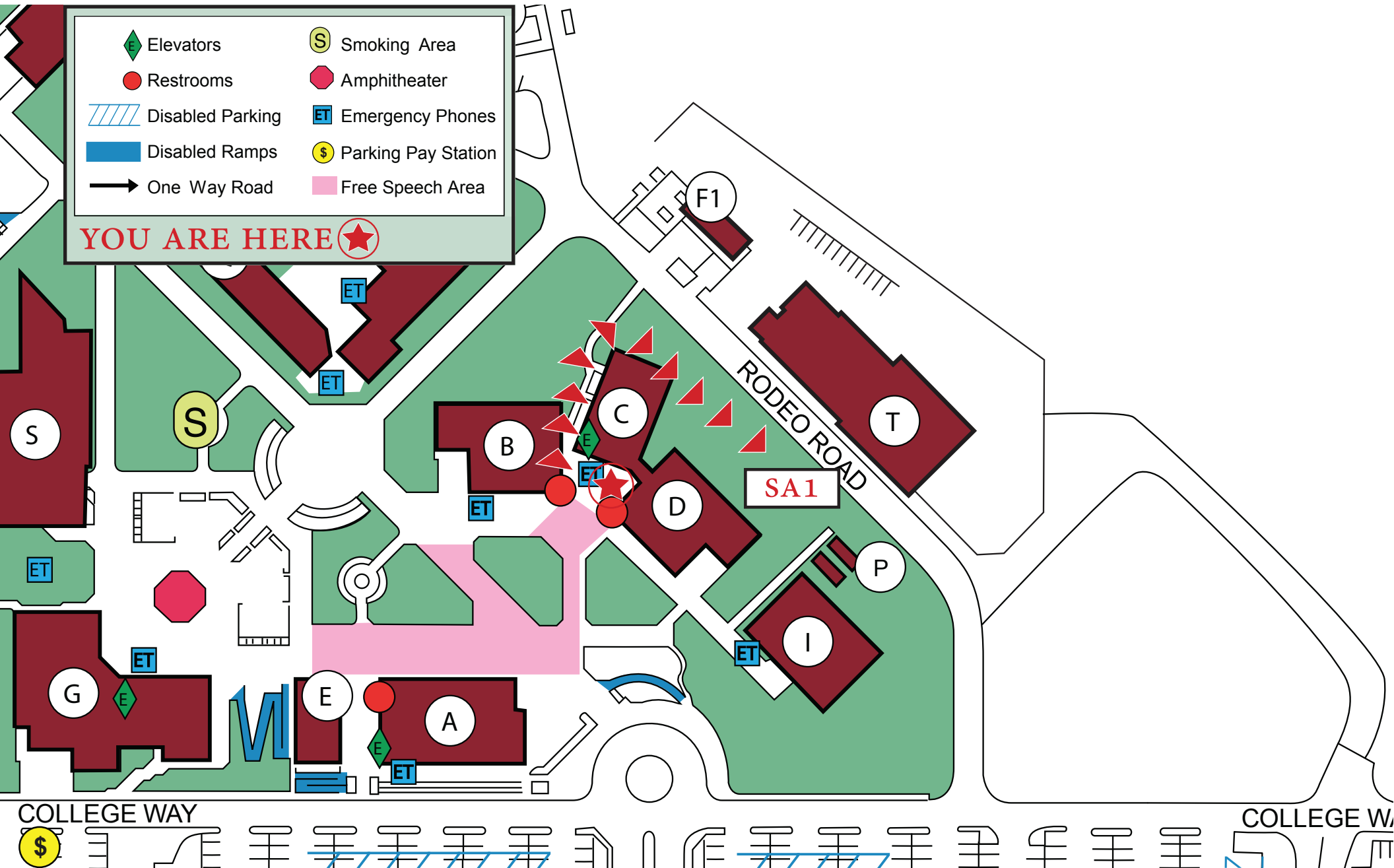
HUMANITIES (HUM) EVACUATION MAP

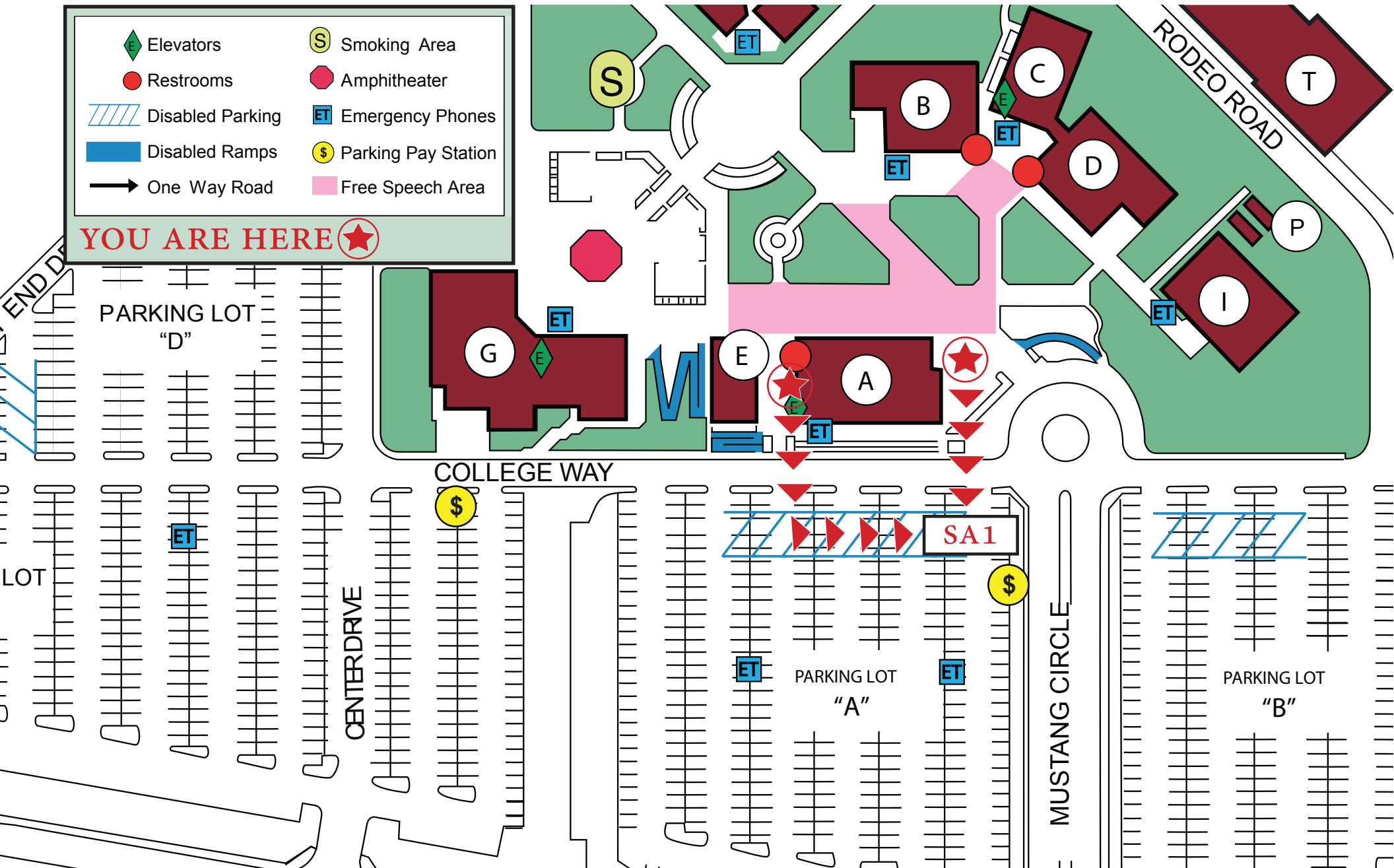
THEATER (THTR) EVACUATION MAP

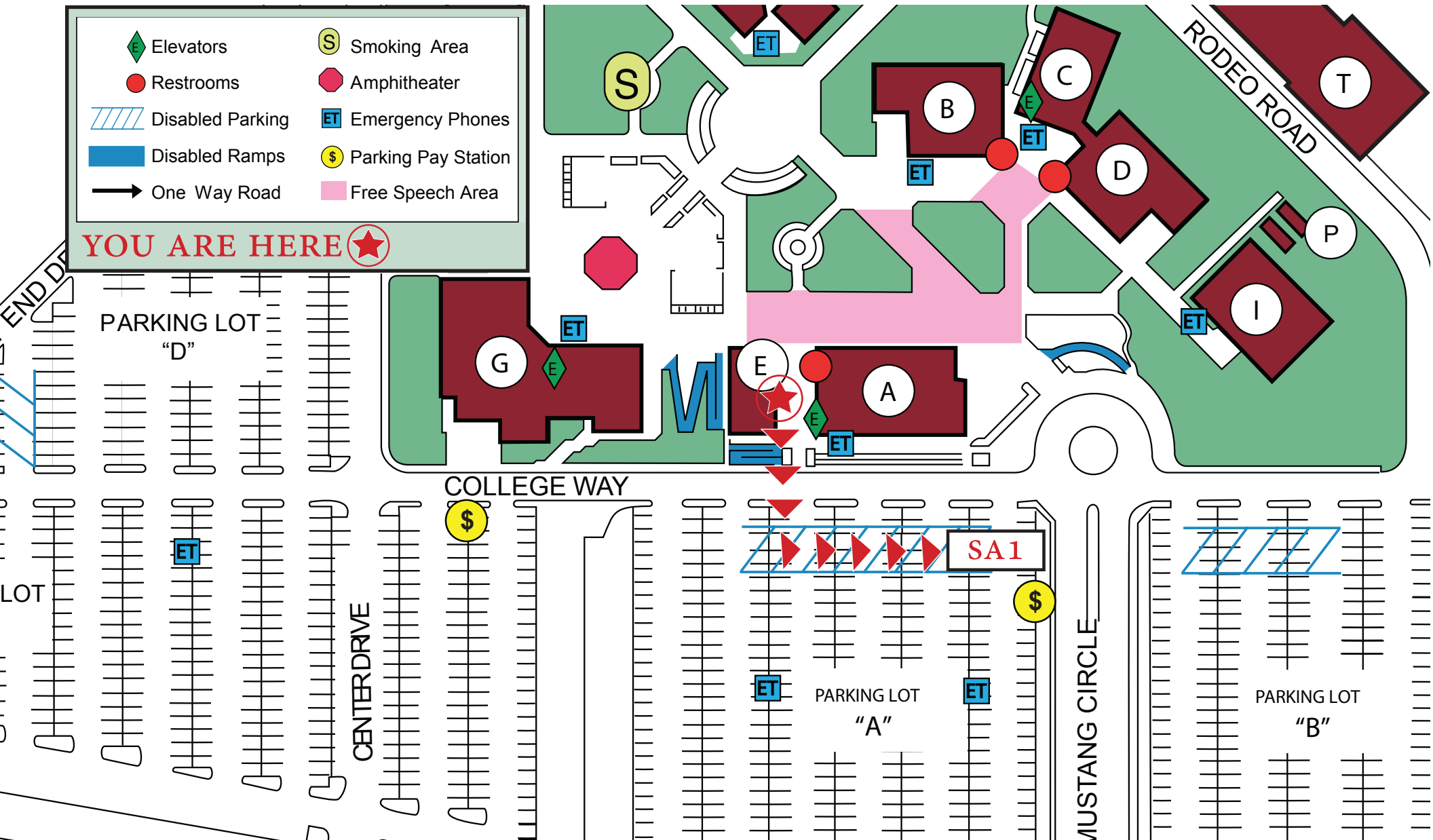
STUDENT SERVICES (SSV) EVACUATION MAP

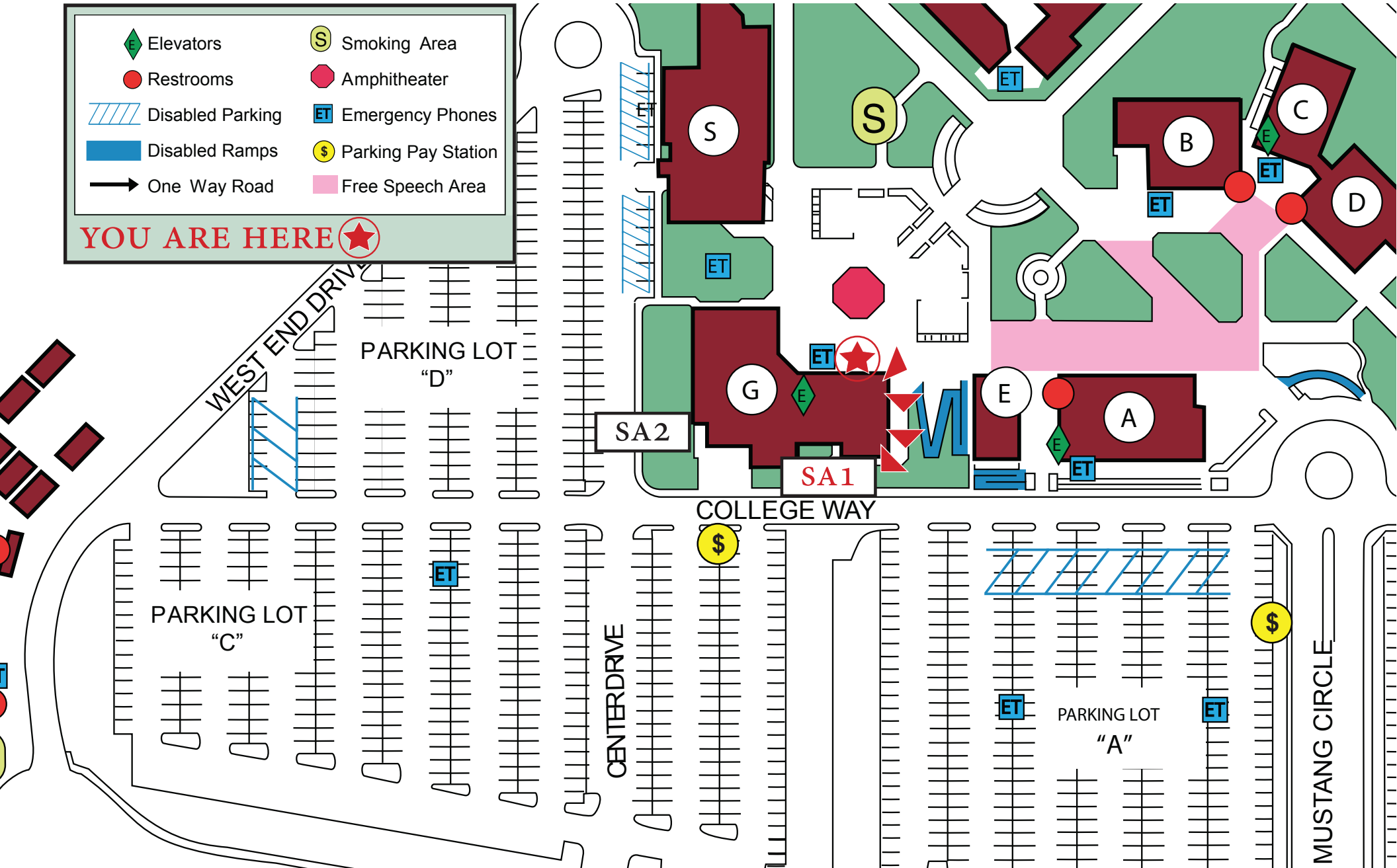


WILFRED J. AIRELY LIBRARY (LIBR) DOWNSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP

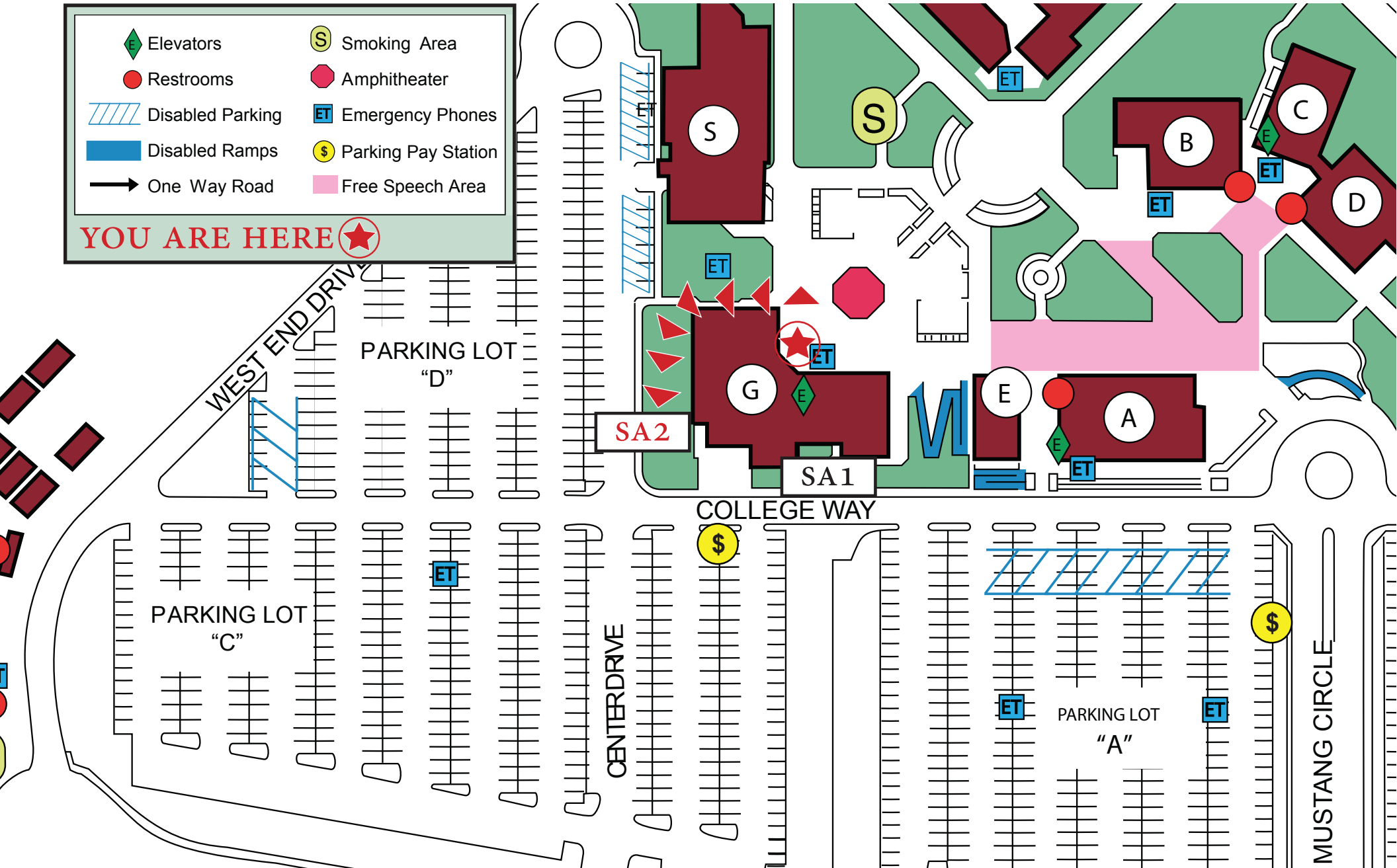


WILFRED J. AIRELY LIBRARY (LIBR) DOWNSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP

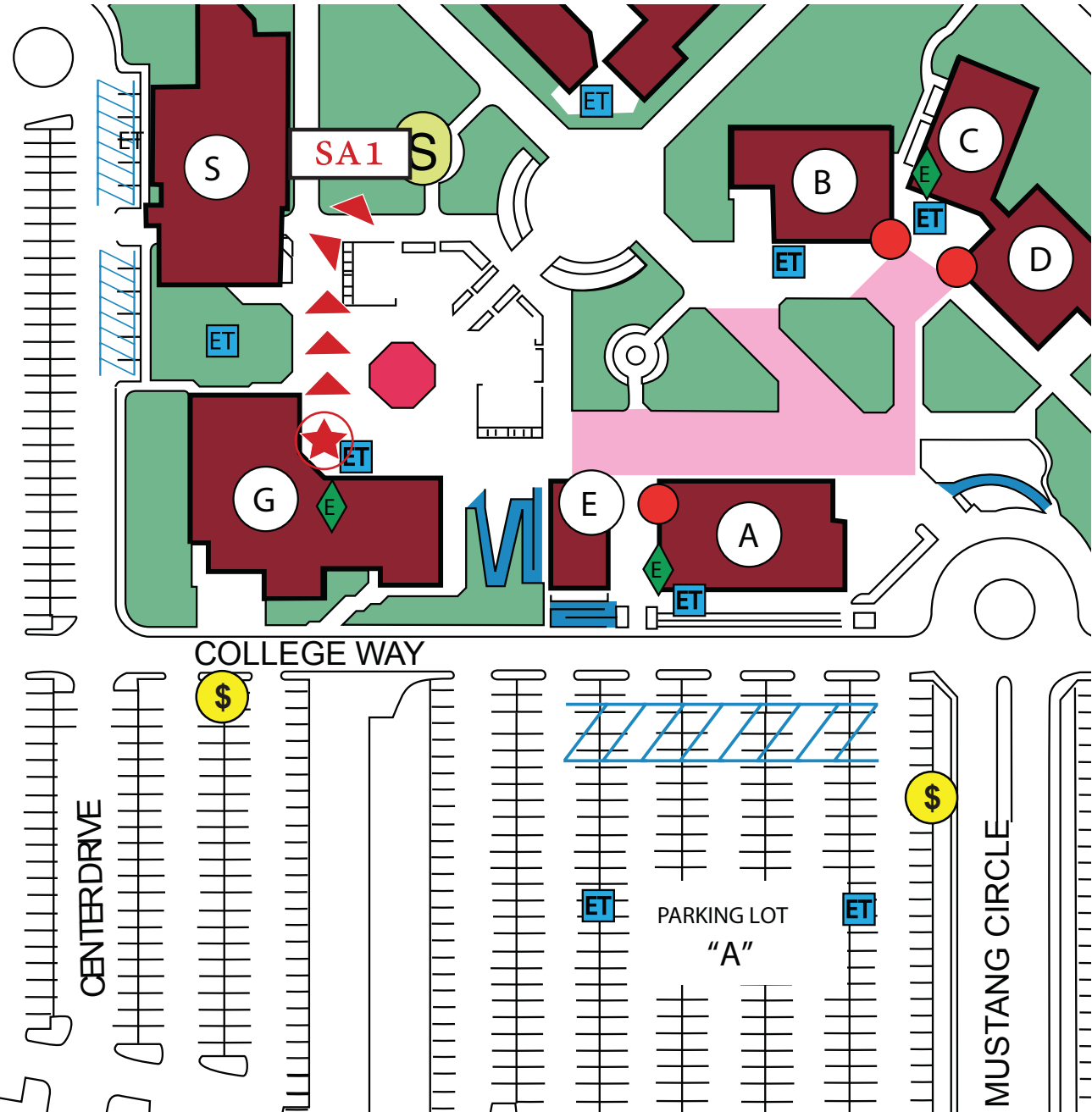


WILFRED J. AIRELY LIBRARY (LIBR) UPSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP

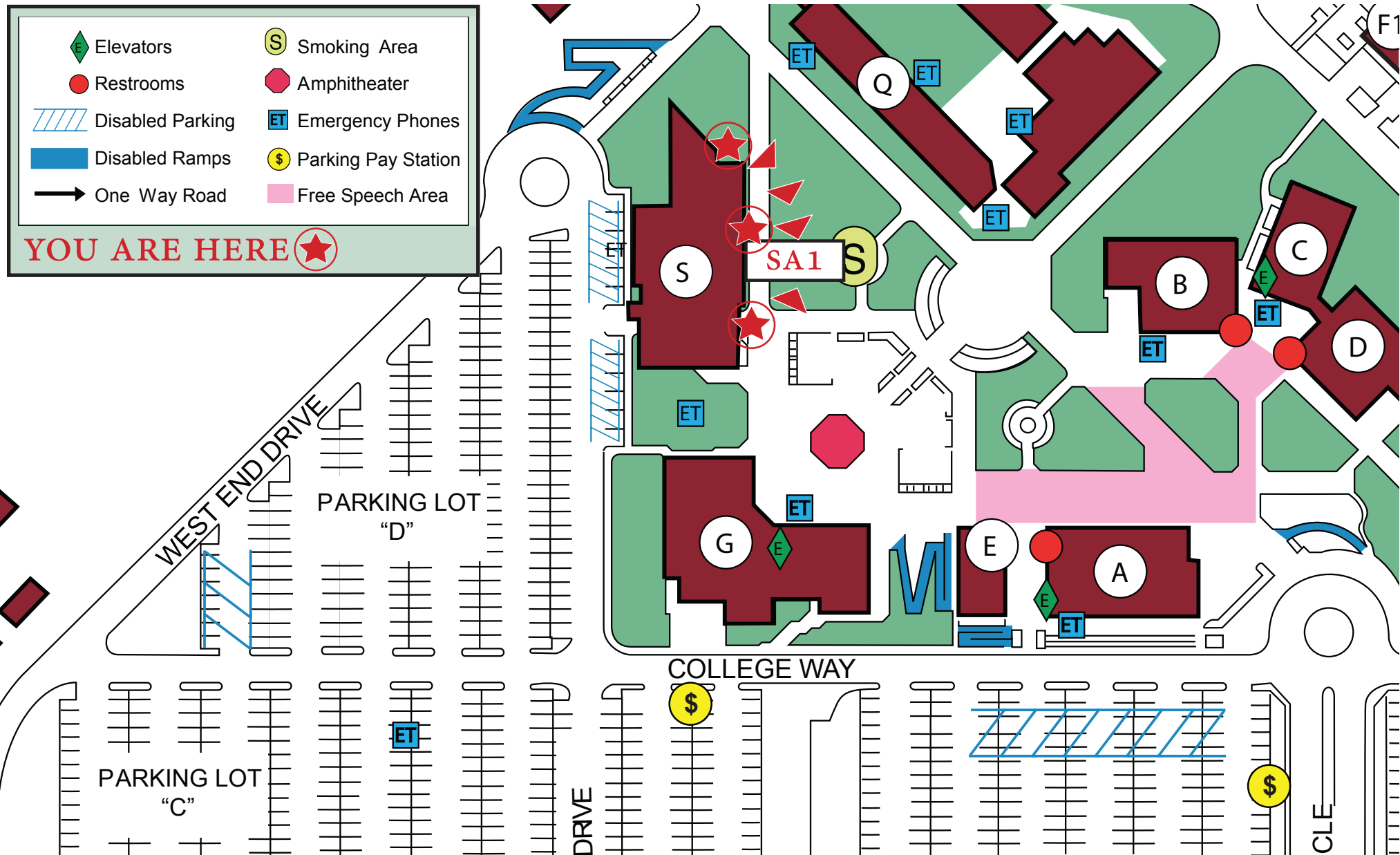

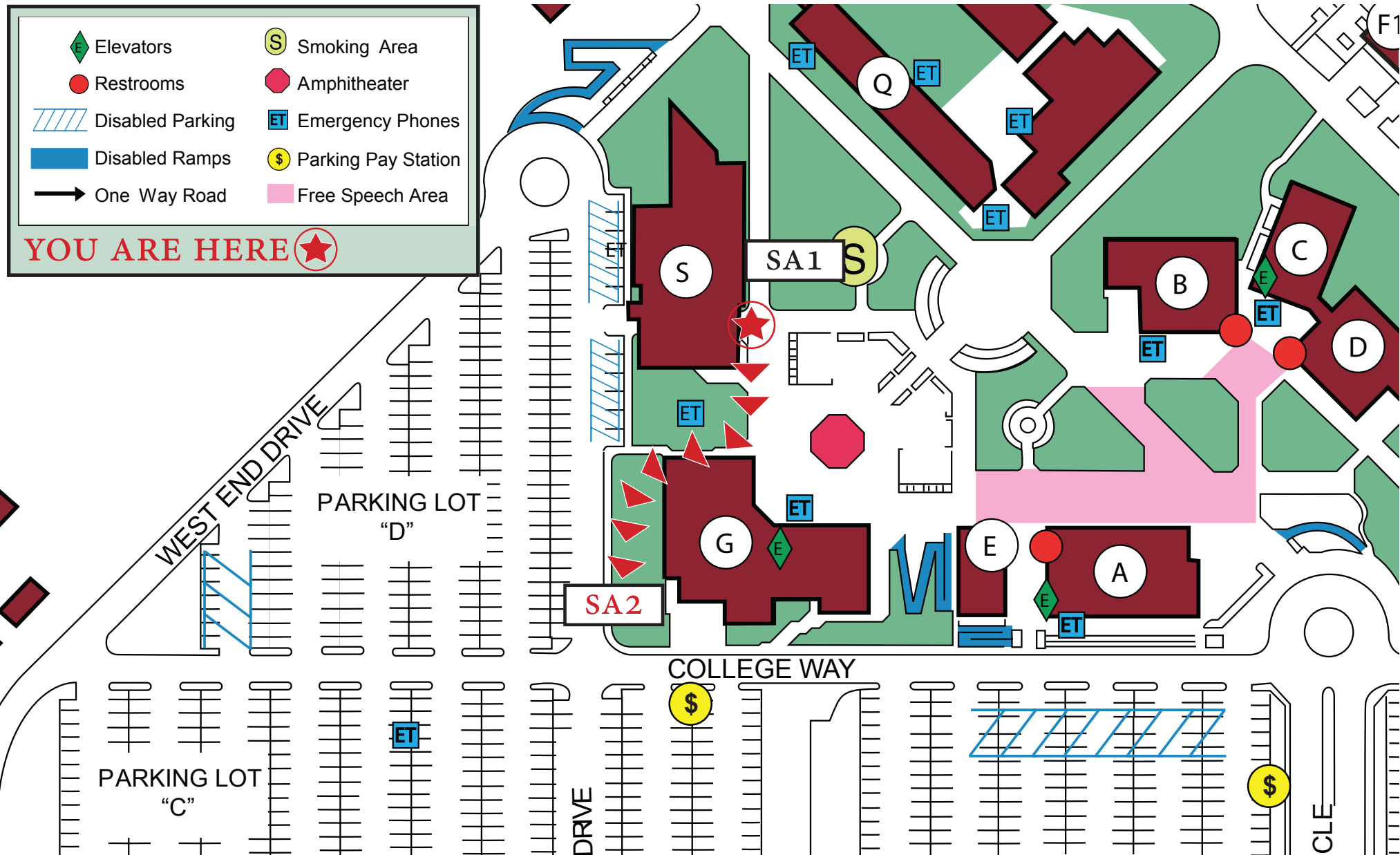
BRENDA AND WILLIAM DAVIS CENTER FOR STUDENT SUCCESS (CSS) UPSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP

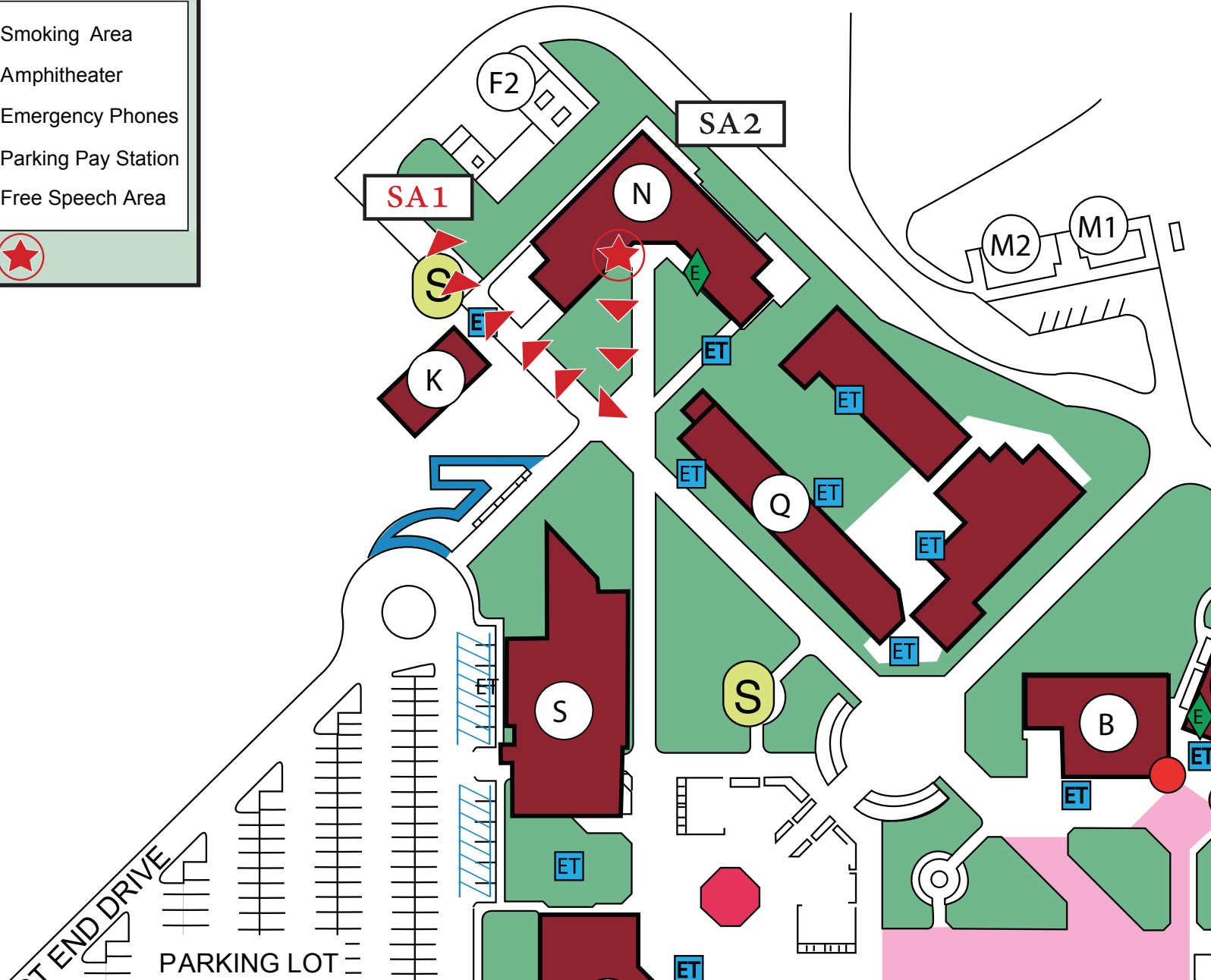

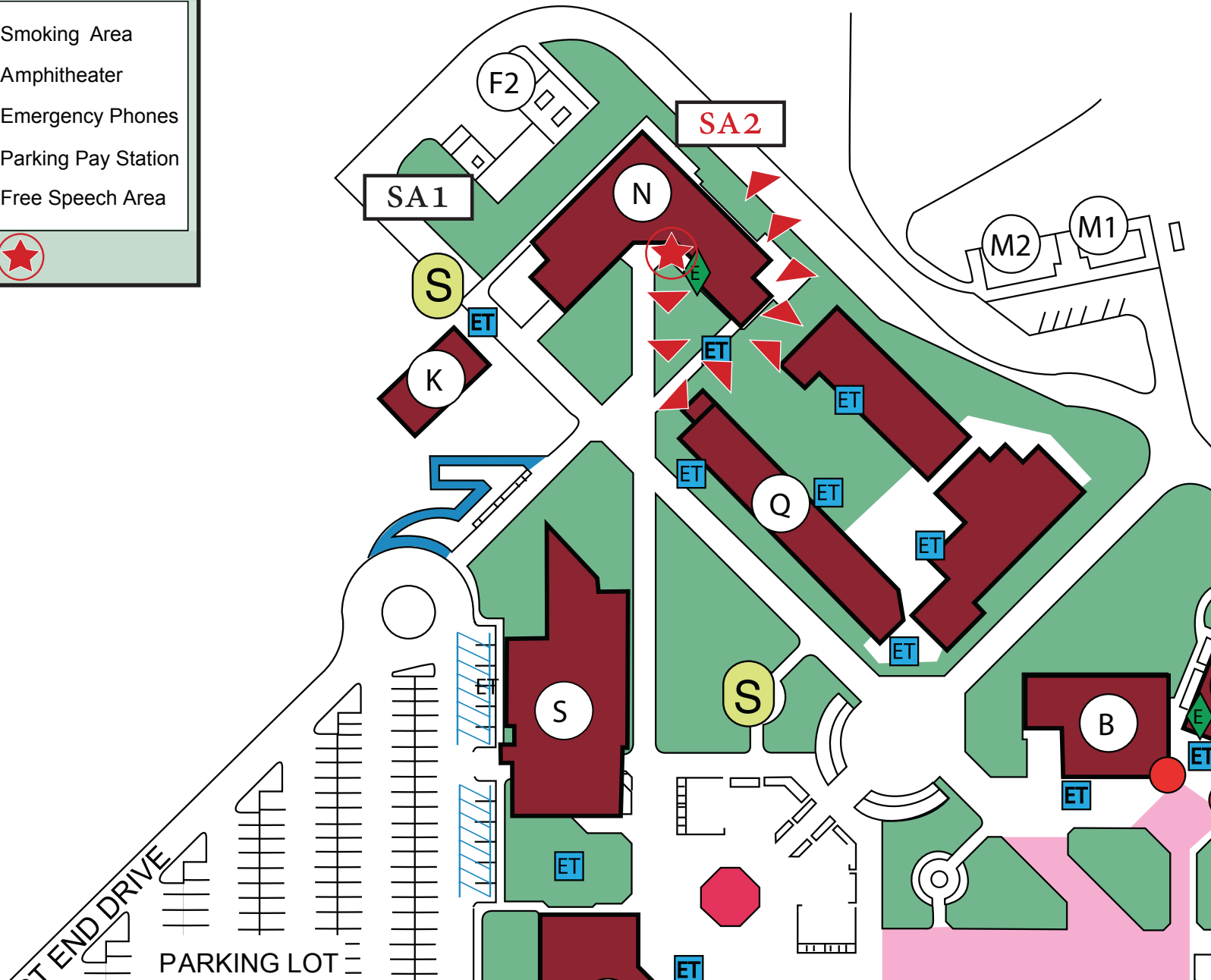


APPLIED TECHNOLOGY (AT) EVACUATION MAP

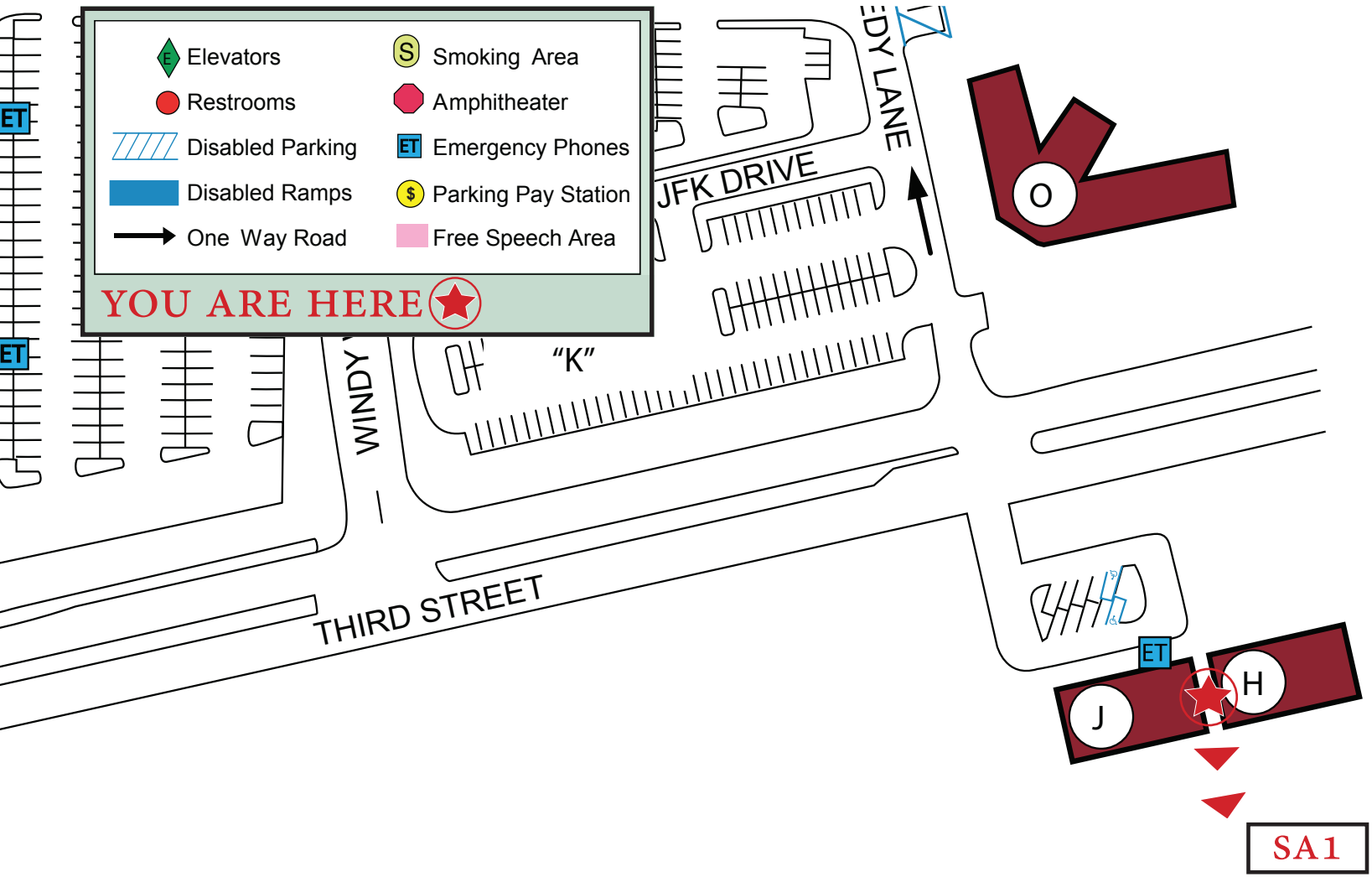

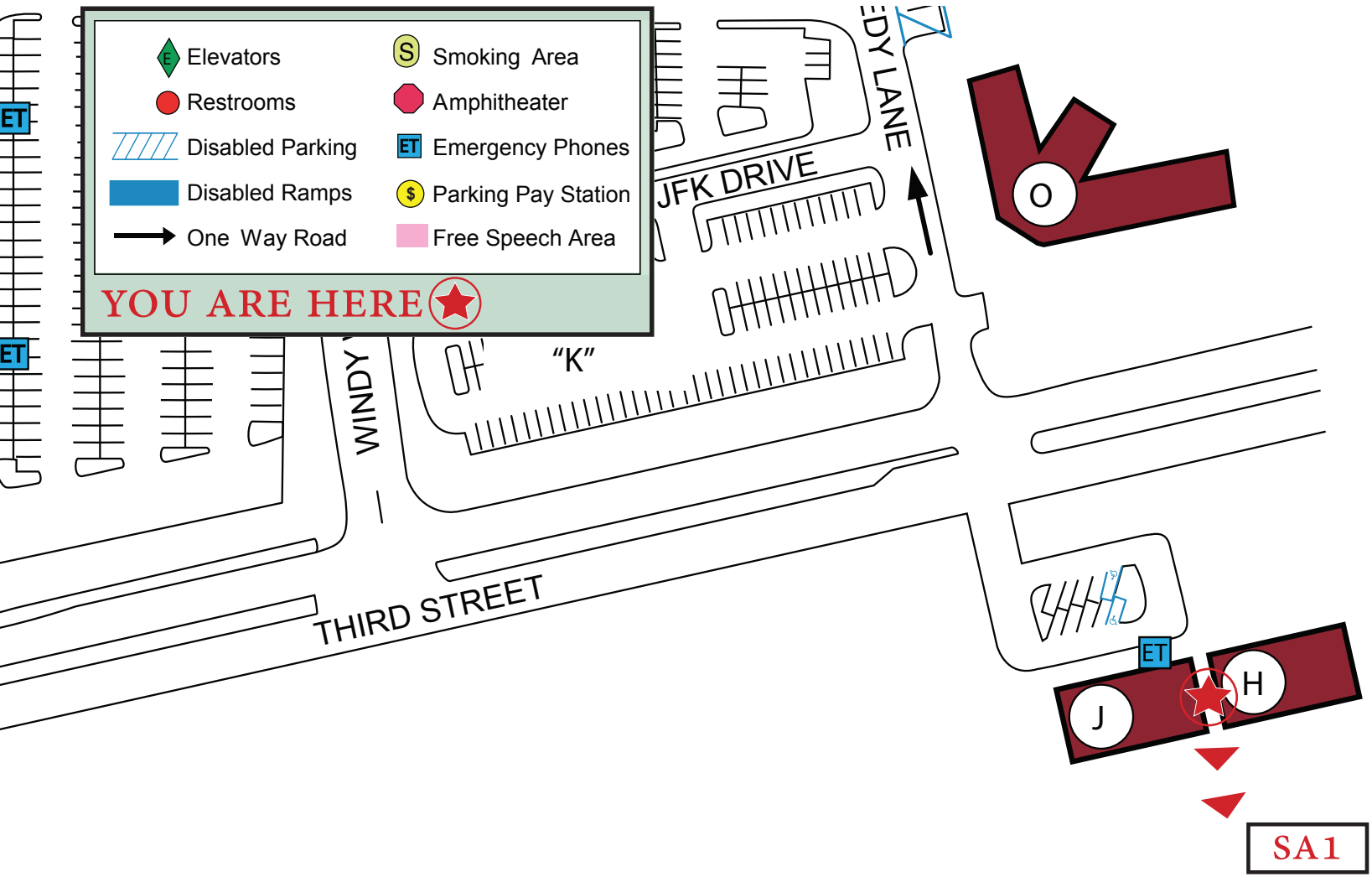
STEM CENTER EVACUATION MAP

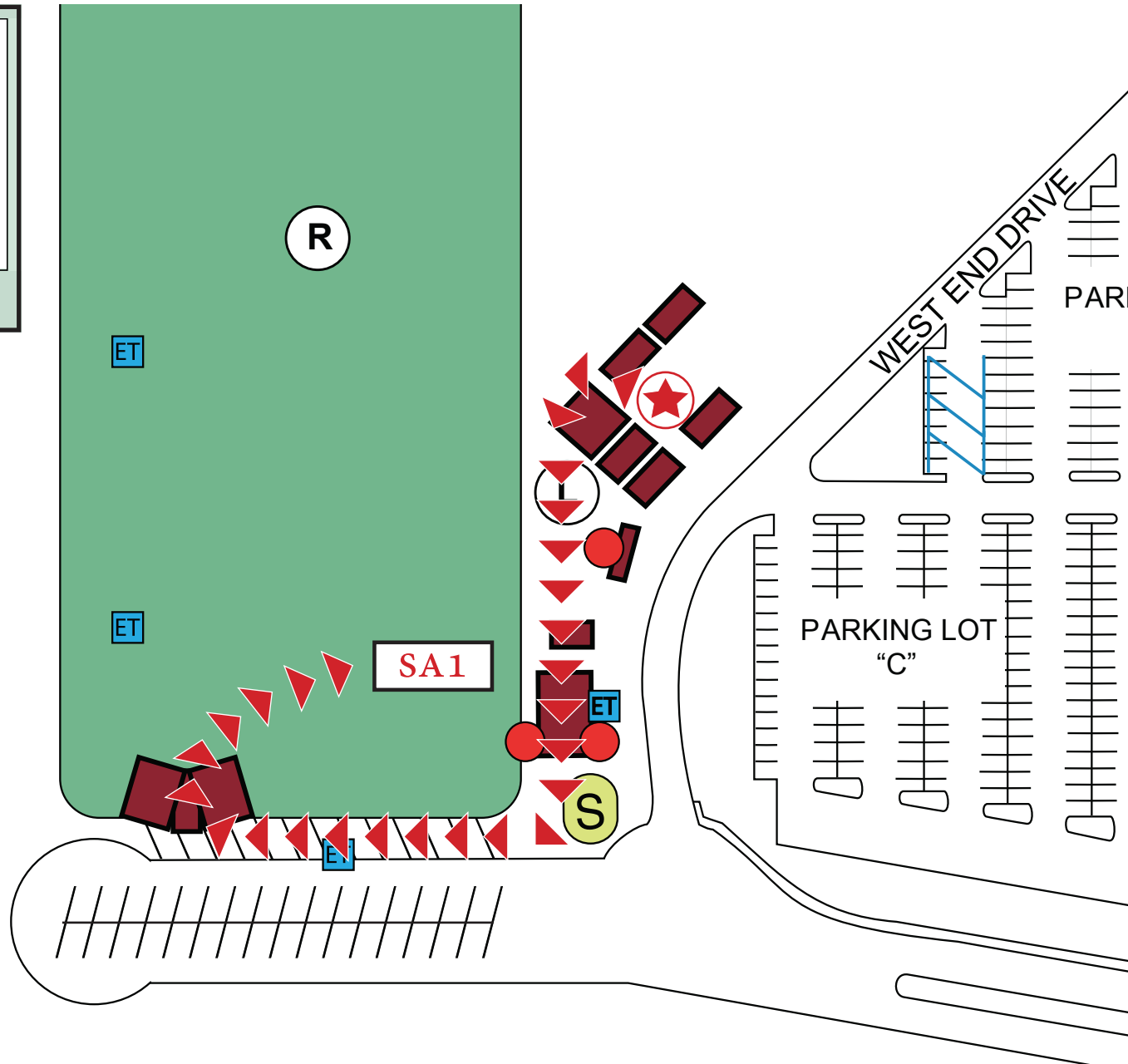


WEST END QUAD EVACUATION MAP

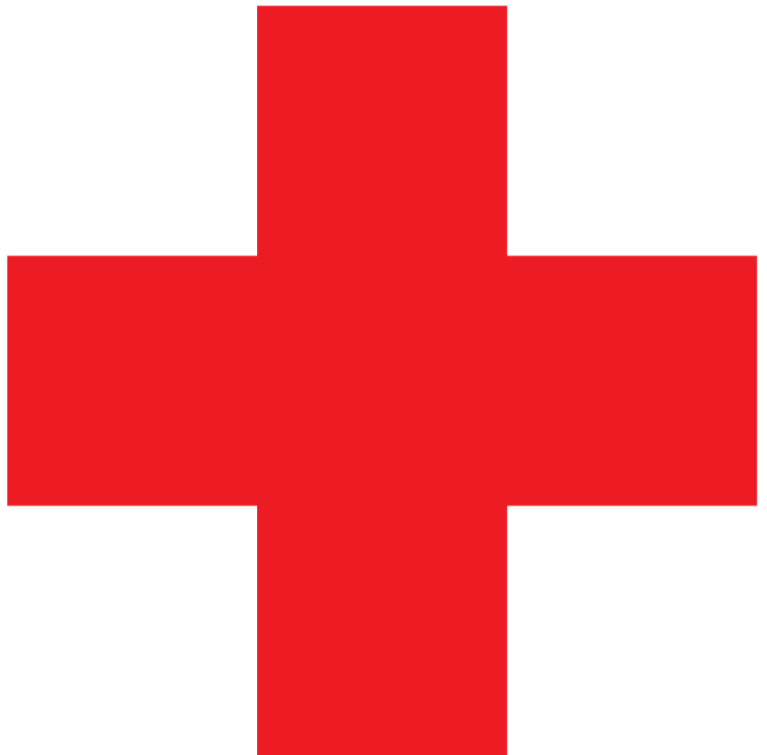
