## STUDENT TRANSITION PROGRAMS AT UC:

- UCR Updates: Jolene Tuz-Sedita
  - 2 major name changes: Theatre changed to Theatre, Film, and Digital Productions and Woman's Studies changed to Gender/Sexuality Studies
  - Sustainability studies Sciences now built into Gender/Sexuality Studies
  - TAG deadline is tomorrow (Sept 30) Student contact begin in mid-November
  - o Transfer Day: Friday, October 9 (Deadline to RSVP is Thurs 10/1)
  - o Open House for Freshmen at the Transfer/Discover Day (Sat Nov 7)
  - o Transfer Honor Society: Tau Sigma Requirement: 3.5 GPA in first quarter
  - o Transfer club also available
  - Student parent organization (Returning/transfer students)
  - New student transfer commuter lounge just opened in Fall
  - New transfer opportunity program (TOP) mentors/resources available
  - New HASS001 2 unit class (100+ seats for all majors) It focuses on workshops and services resources geared specifically towards to transfer students
  - Transfer pathways: more information coming out to clear up some student confusion

- UCLA Updates: Olivia Chen
  - o 15, 000 transfer students applied (500 admitted) 50 from Norco 15 admitted.
  - o Transfer pathways may make it easier for Norco students to attend UCLA
  - STOMP Volunteer Student Transfer Outreach Mentor Program mentorship and transfer opportunities. April conference (Tentative; 4<sup>th</sup> Friday) www.Admission.ucla.edu/stomp (campus tours/workshops/resources/etc)
  - Transfer conference (formerly known as TAP) Friday Oct 23 8:30-3:30pm (Free) Workshops/resources/financial aid/tours (RSVP deadline is Oct 18)
  - UC Santa Barbara: Andy Chau
    - o "Transfer Course" now available
    - Transfer student specific apartment complex recently opened (\$650 per student/double occupancy) Capacity of approximately 1000-1500 students.
    - Engineering recommend they do not finish their general ed before transfer to make sure they are on track while they are at UCSB
    - High Biology prep courses require 2.75 GPA
    - TAG 3.2 GPA (Performance arts, theatre, etc. anything that require audition are not included)
    - o Transfer day / open house (date April TBA)

# **ADT UPDATE:** Marissa Iliscupidez

- August 31 was the deadline for ADT (Associate Degrees for Transfer)
- Currently verifying submitted ADT's (Oct 31 deadline)
- Business ADT was approved by the state (In catalog by January)
- History ADT approved by district (waiting for state approval)
- Biology ADT approved by district (waiting for state approval)
- Chemistry ADT approved by district (waiting for state approval)
- Admin of Justice ADT (Nick Franco is currently working with Alexis Gray)
- After all approvals Norco will have 17 ADT's!

## **HONORS UPDATE:** Marissa Iliscupidez

- 5 sections of Honors courses in Fall / 6 in Spring (New BIO1)
- Watch for Nor-all Honors updates. ELIGIBLILITY REQUIREMENTS: Honors English 1A completed or eligible, 3.0GPA, and 9 units completed see website for application (Counseling front counter can scan and email to Debbie McDowell if the student has computer problems or no access to printer/scanner)
- UCLA is auditing Norco College's Honors program. Report due by 10/15
- Norco has had 3 TAP scholars admitted to UCLA since 2011 (\$10,000 renewable scholarship)
- In Fall 2015 Norco filled all of their 5 Honors sections!

#### TRANSFER PATHWAY UPDATES: Natalie Aceves

- UC Transfer Pathway
  - Group viewed the new Transfer Pathways UC website. Under Admissions, Transfer
  - http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/transfer/major
- CSU Associates Degree for Transfer redirection
  - Various majors has been "redirected" from university to university, but there was no student notification
  - Some universities were not honoring the "redirected applications" so Students are still encouraged to apply directly to each individual university

## STUDENT SUCCESS ACTIVITY UPDATE & TRANSFER DATA: Natalie Aceves

- **Goal 1; Obj. 1:** Increase Student Achievement and Success; Improve transfer preparedness (complete 60 transferable units with a 2.0 GPA or higher).
  - One activity was to target student who completed 30 transferable units and Math/Eng completed)
  - o Number of students who met this criteria in April was: 1,929
  - o One idea was to have a "celebration" reception for these students
  - o Another idea is to focus on the students who have a lower GPA, to help them get their GPA up to 2.0.
  - o Idea: Is there a way to take an "exit" survey on students who withdraw from all their classes? This would help us better identify common issues, problems that we might be able to address.
  - The new Title V grant may help in meeting this goal

  - o CA.Gov webpage: Management Information Systems DataMart
- UC Transfer Data Review
  - Group reviewed the new enrollment at UC systems
