1. Call to Order 12:50 p.m.
2. Consent Calendar- Ruth Leal
 - a. April 20, 2017 Minutes were not provided. Will provide at a future meeting.
3. Committee Business – Shirley
 - a. None.
4. Technology Plan – Ruth
 - a. Subcommittees Report - Ms. Leal provided an update regarding the subcommittees.
 - i. Goal #1 – The subcommittee is working on a technology workshop for the summer staff development day. The topic is being determined by input from the Technology Survey 2016 from staff. Leonard Riley will be conducting the workshop.
 - ii. Goal #2 – The Technology Committee reviewed the function map for Standard IIIC and provided input on whether the college is the primary, secondary, or share with the other colleges and/or district office. Item #1 was discussed and the committee felt that the college provides this function through program review, technology survey, updating inventory, and the

refresh plan. Item #2 it was determined that the college has the primary function. #3 the college has the primary function through TSS/IMC and planning via program review through the Technology Committee. #4 the college has the primary function as noted through technology training workshops and Lynda.com. #5 was discussed and the college has a role in this through the Technology Principles and Guidelines that could be added but the District also has a role through board policy.

- iii. Goal #6 – The subcommittee will work with the Technology Support Services on providing an updated inventory list to reflect the computers that were replaced in Phase I and II. It is important that we have an updated list as part of the Technology Plan and for Accreditation.
- iv. Goal #7 - The Technology Survey was sent out to the college the first week of May and it was reported that there have been some responses but that many more were needed. The committee was asked to encourage their fellow faculty, staff, and students to take the Technology Survey because it leads to results and that the committee uses it as the basis for recommendations. ASNC have been asked to help get the word out and assist students with taking the survey in the Student Activities computer area. Their assistance has been valuable in years past and is still needed to help students have a voice in technology on campus.

b. Lynda.com Recommendation & Satisfaction Survey

- i. It was reported that Lynda.com was funded for the year. The satisfaction survey was reviewed and lynda.com received very good responses. Marketing has begun to raise awareness to students about Lynda.com. The top workshop requests from the 2016 Technology Survey by students showed 1) Adobe Photoshop 2) lynda.com 3) Microsoft excel 4) game development 5) programming and so the marketing campaign will focus on these to interest students in checking out lynda.com and inform them of how to sign up for a free account. The campaign will include social media posts and digital signs on campus. A suggestion was made to have a student workshop in the fall.

c. Equipment Refresh Recommendation

- i. An updated list of office computers for Phase II was presented to the group and it was announced that the list was funded by program review. It was emphasized that the computer is being updated so even if the name is not accurate, the computer will be replaced. The committee reviewed the Phase III list and it was noted that the list is not complete with purchase date information making it difficult to know how old the computers are but there were some in the list that are five years old and will be six years by the time they are potentially funded. After discussion on how to proceed, the committee determined that if purchase dates are not known that we recommend only computers that the age is known and only computers that were purchased in 2012/2013 or earlier be placed as a recommendation for refresh on program review.

Motion (Lee/Brotherton): Approved. No abstentions.

- ii. The list for computer labs that need to be recommended was reviewed. It was noted that IT 208 changed from a CIS Lab to something else. The Technology Committee's recommendation from the 2016 program review cycle were not funded with the exception of IT125. The Technology Committee discussed and made a recommendation to place the NC TC Computer Lab Refresh 2017 on program review.

Motion (Finley/Brotherton): Approved. No abstentions.

5. Technology Projects – Shirley and Dan

a. TSS Update

Ms. McGraw informed that TSS will start the interview process next week for a permanent part-time employee. The Student Portal Project Updates should be in the testing phase. IT has students working on getting students into the Active Directory and working through the process. TSS is getting ready to start installing equipment that was funded from program review. The Library's 20 new computers are being imaged. Upward Bound has 6 new computer installs. There are 32 open TSS/IMC work order requests for some type of repair.

As an update to the LanDesk software, inventory software that the District purchased, is that TSS staff, Ricardo Aguilera, went for training in May.

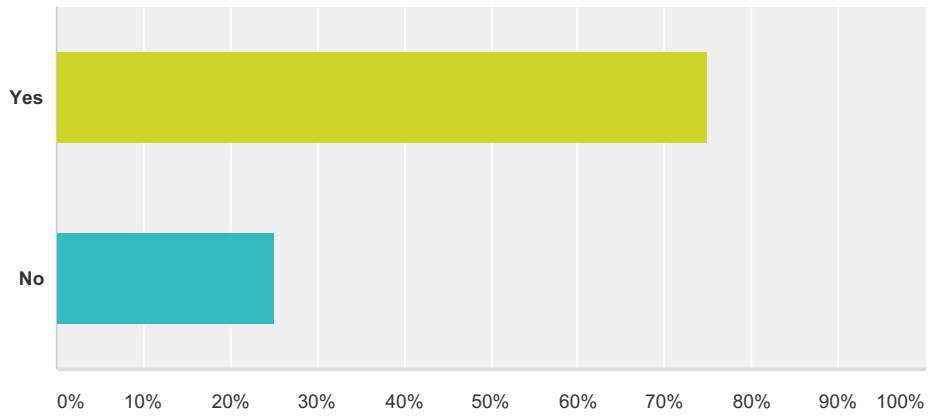

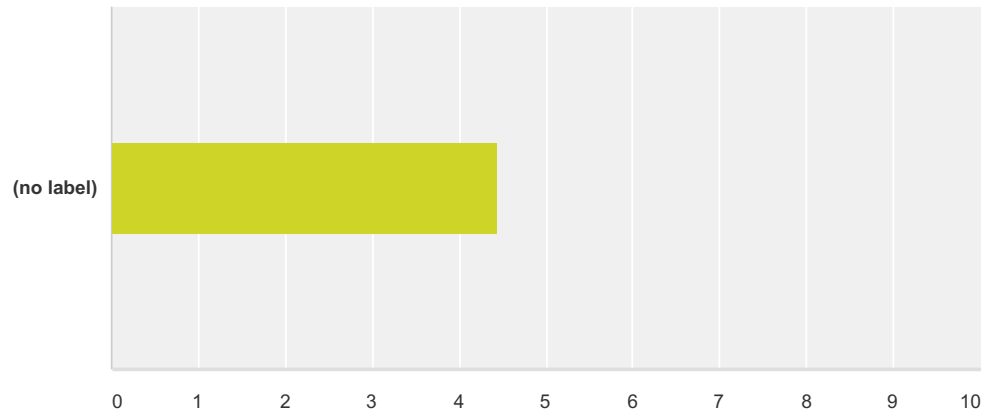

Q2 On a scale of one to five, how useful was it? Did it meet your needs?

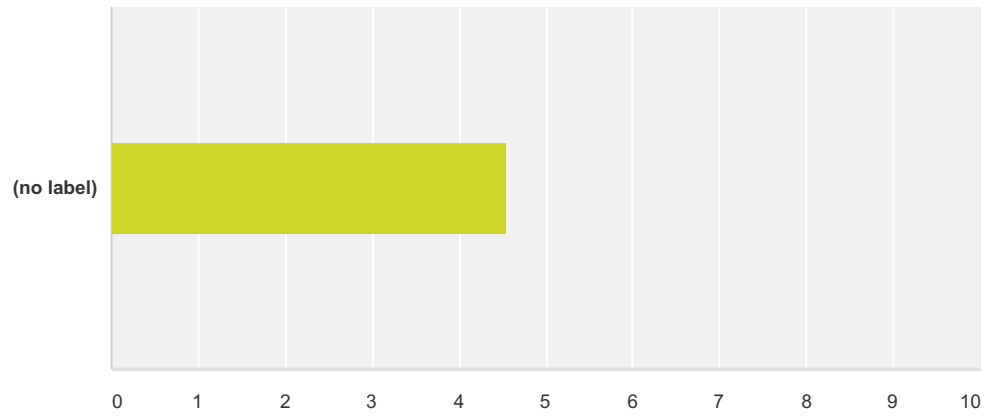

Q3 On a scale of one to five, how convenient was it to use the service?

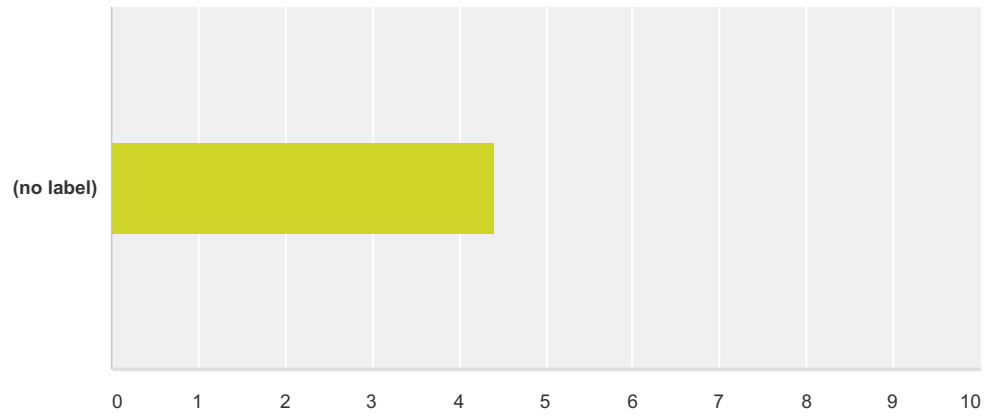

Q4 On a scale of one to five, how would you rate the quality of the course(s) you took?

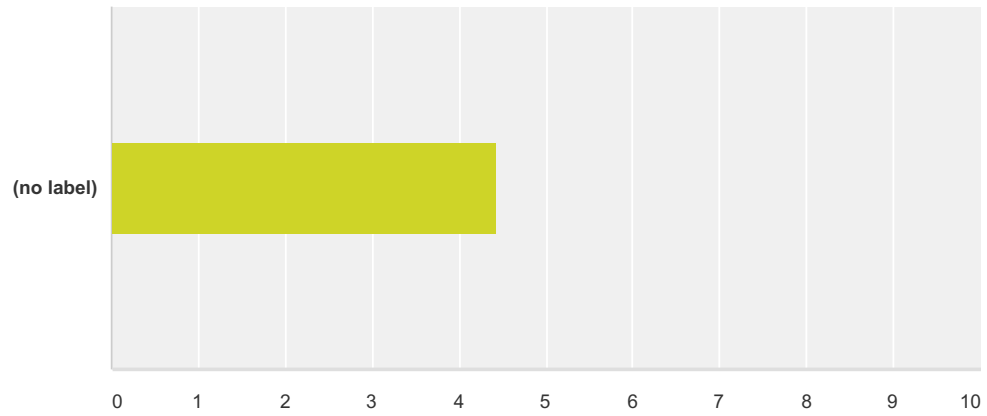
