

Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) 2014-2015

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There are other courses that can fulfill these requirements; for a complete list of options, please see the Norco College Catalog.

Once completed, the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) system generally without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses. Some of the UC campuses do not accept or recommend IGETC for certain majors (i.e. Engineering, Sciences).

It is recommended that all students with the goal of transfer to a 4-year university develop a Student Educational Plan (SEP). A Norco College counselor can assist you in developing a SEP for your specific goals.

Transfer Students will receive IGETC certification after completing all of the subject areas below with a minimum "C" grade or better.

Courses cannot be double-counted to satisfy more than one area. The only exception to this is several courses in Area 6 which can also be counted towards Area 3B.

Courses that may be applied to one of two different areas are listed only in one area, with the second option listed in parenthesis.

CSU ONLY: Although not part of the GE requirement for transfer, 6 semester units of US History, Constitution and Government is a CSU graduation requirement that students may complete at Norco College prior to transfer. HIS-6 or 6H or 7 or 7H and POL-1 or 1H satisfy this requirement.
