- French Guiana, an overseas department and region of France, reported their first COVID-19 death, for a cumulative total of 97 COVID-19 cases including one (1) death reported to date. Of the 54 countries/territories in the region, 43 have now reported at least one (1) COVID-19 death (80%). The remaining 11 countries/territories without any reported COVID-19 death are all in the Caribbean subregion..




