

An additional 33,101 cases and 3,043 deaths were reported in the past 24 hours, representing a 3% and 4% relative increase in total cases and deaths respectively compared to the previous day. Majority of the new cases (20,517) and deaths (2,010) continue to be reported from the United States of America, which has now crossed the threshold of over 1 million COVID-19 cases including 57,730 deaths as of today.



WHO officials say they are studying the link between rare inflammatory disease and Covid-19 in children

- A rare inflammatory condition called Kawasaki disease that has emerged as a possible complication of coronavirus infection in young children, officials in Europe said during a media briefing on Thursday.
- While there have been rare reports of cases in London and other parts of Europe, "only half of these children tested positive for coronavirus," Adam Finn, professor of pediatrics at the University of Bristol and chairman of the European Technical Advisory Group of Experts advising WHO Europe, said during the briefing.

Excessive Heat Warning, in effect 10 AM Tuesday through 9 PM Thursday.

- Temperatures will climb again Tuesday and Wednesday, with Wednesday expected to be the hottest day of the week for most locations
- Dangerous heat will affect our deserts, and heat risk may be heightened for inland valleys west of the mountains as well, particularly in the Inland Empire on Wednesday.
- Lower Deserts will likely see lingering dangerous heat through Thursday, before temperatures cool and bring an end to the prolonged, early-season heat wave.
