Scientists find evidence that novel coronavirus infects the mouth's cells

- An international team of scientists has found evidence that SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19, can infect cells in other parts of the body, such as the digestive system, blood vessels, kidneys and, as this new study shows, the mouth.
- The potential of the virus to infect multiple areas of the body might help explain the wide-ranging symptoms experienced by COVID-19 patients, including oral symptoms such as taste loss, dry mouth and blistering.
- The findings point to the possibility that the mouth plays a role in transmitting SARS-CoV-2 to the lungs or digestive system via saliva laden with virus from infected oral cells. A better understanding of the mouth's involvement could inform strategies to reduce viral transmission within and outside the body. The team was led by researchers at the National Institutes of Health and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Syria provides Lebanon oxygen supplies amid dire shortages

- War-torn Syria promised oxygen supplies to neighboring Lebanon as both countries struggle with unprecedented economic woes and a surge of coronavirus infections.

Why are more young people getting sick with Covid-19 in Brazil?

- Since the new year, Brazil has descended into its worst days of this pandemic so far. Daily death and case numbers have shattered previous records.
- Amid the surge, a worrying pattern has emerged—more young people seem to be getting severely ill and dying from Covid-19.
- Officials said 60% of younger patients with Covid-19 needed ICU beds.
- According to a March 4 study of eight Brazilian states by national health research institute Fiocruz, over half of all Covid-19 cases in six states were "associated with variants of concern" including P.1(Brazil), as well as variants first identified in the UK and South Africa.



Biden will announce new Covid vaccine goal: 200 million shots within his first 100 days

- President Joe Biden plans Thursday to announce a new goal of 200 million Covid vaccination shots being given within his first 100 days in office, a White House official told NBC News.
- As of last Friday, the United States had 100 million coronavirus vaccinations conducted. That benchmark which was Biden's original target — was reached on his 59th day in office.
