COVID case statistics are reported by local health departments to CaIREDIE and are pulled at 2pm. Hospital data and case statistics are integrated by the California Department of Technology and made available through the Open Data Portal the following morning. CA Open Data Portal is at least 24 Hours behind although a backlog of new case reports at the State level has ostensibly been cleared, some County dashboards still contain notes that indicate data are missing. \*California Demographics from State Database Blueprint Data Chart 12-15-20 & census.gov .
