Distracted nurse gives woman 6 doses of COVID vaccine in a single shot

- Rome — A 23-year-old Italian woman who was mistakenly given six doses of the Pfizer coronavirus vaccine all at once was released from a hospital on Monday without having suffered any apparent adverse reactions, local health authorities said. The incident occurred on Sunday morning at the Noa Hospital in Massa, in Tuscany.
- The patient was kept under observation for approximately 24 hours in the hospital's emergency room. Doctors said she was given fluids, and anti-inflammatory and fever medications as preventative measures.

Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine Expanded To U.S. Children 12 And Older

- COVID-19 vaccines finally are headed for more kids as U.S. regulators on Monday expanded use of Pfizer's shot to those as young as 12, sparking a race to protect middle and high school students before they head back to class in the fall.
- Shots could begin as soon as a federal vaccine advisory committee issues recommendations for using the two-dose vaccine in 12- to 15-year-olds, expected Wednesday.

- Two recent studies in the journal Nature provide some of the most-detailed analyses yet about the effects on the human body of SARS-CoV-2, the coronavirus that causes COVID-19.
- The research shows that in people with advanced infections, SARS-CoV-2 often unleashes a devastating series of host events in the lungs prior to death. These events include runaway inflammation and rampant tissue destruction that the lungs cannot repair.

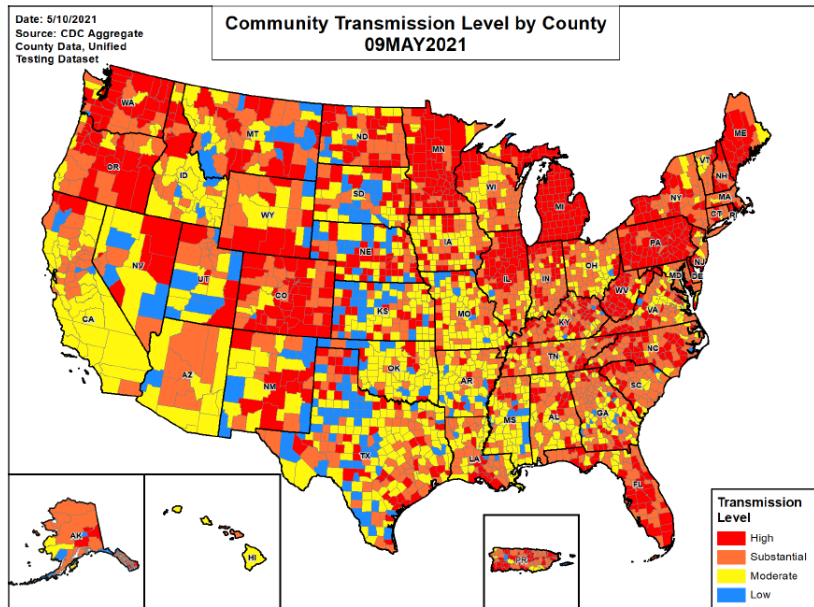

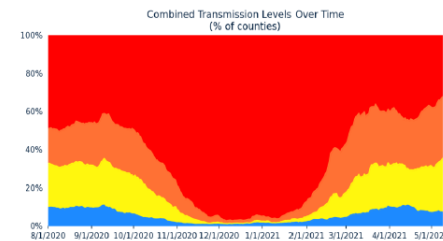
COMMUNITY TRANSMISSION LEVEL

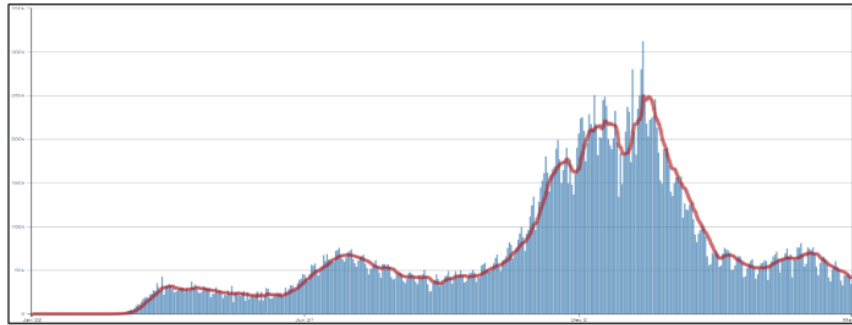

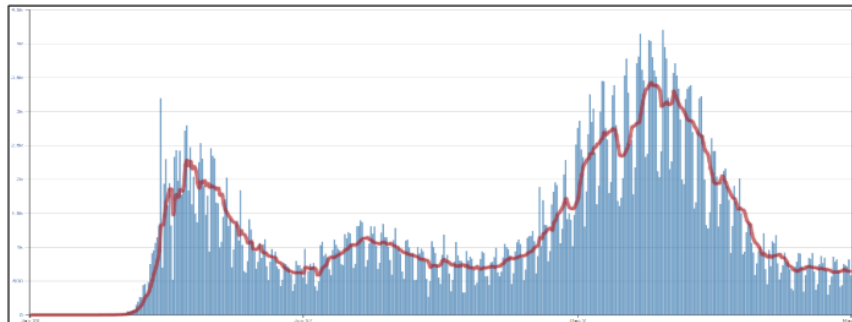

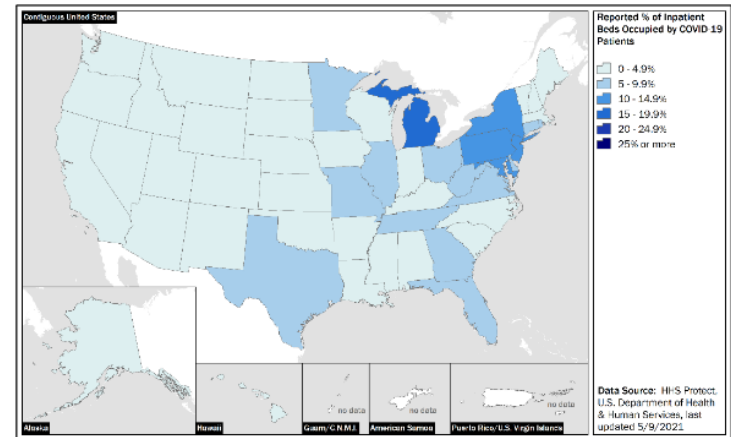
Daily Trends of COVID-19 Cases



Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths

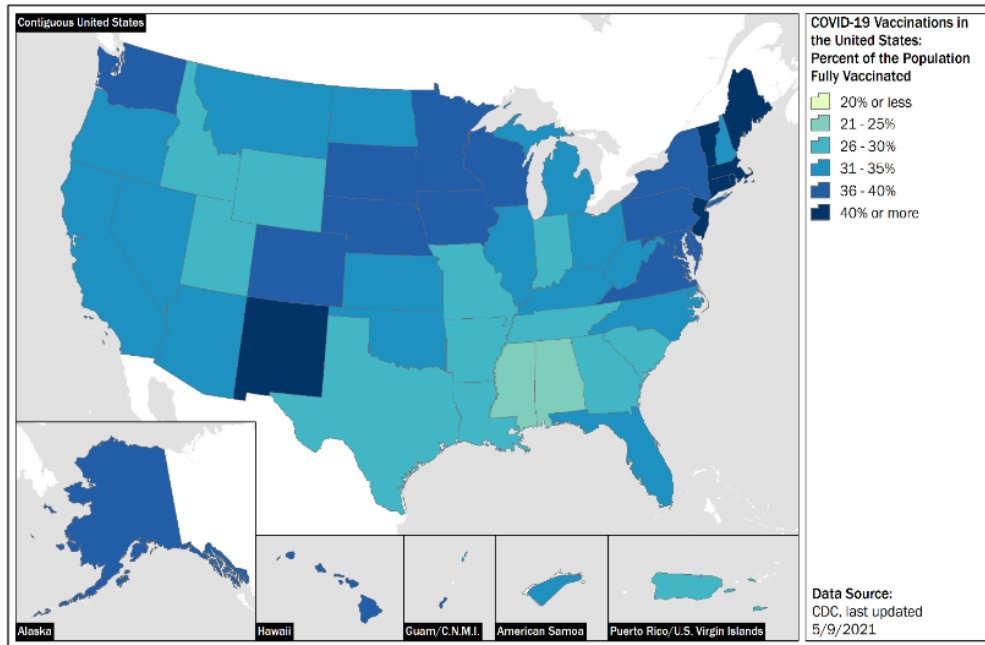

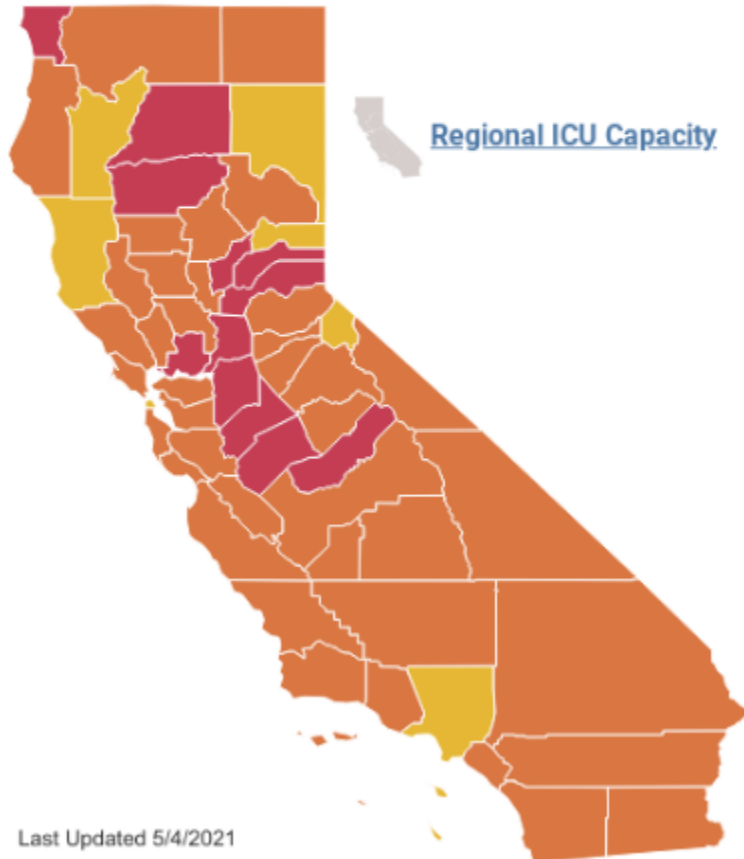

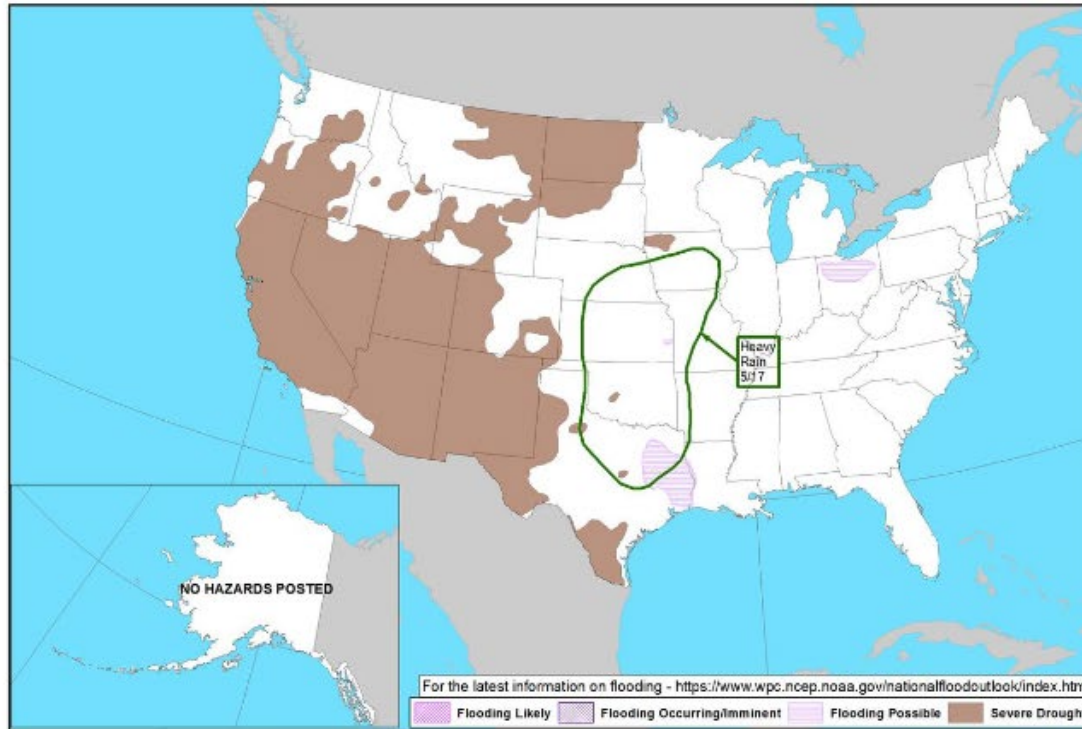
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

Hazards Outlook - May 13-17

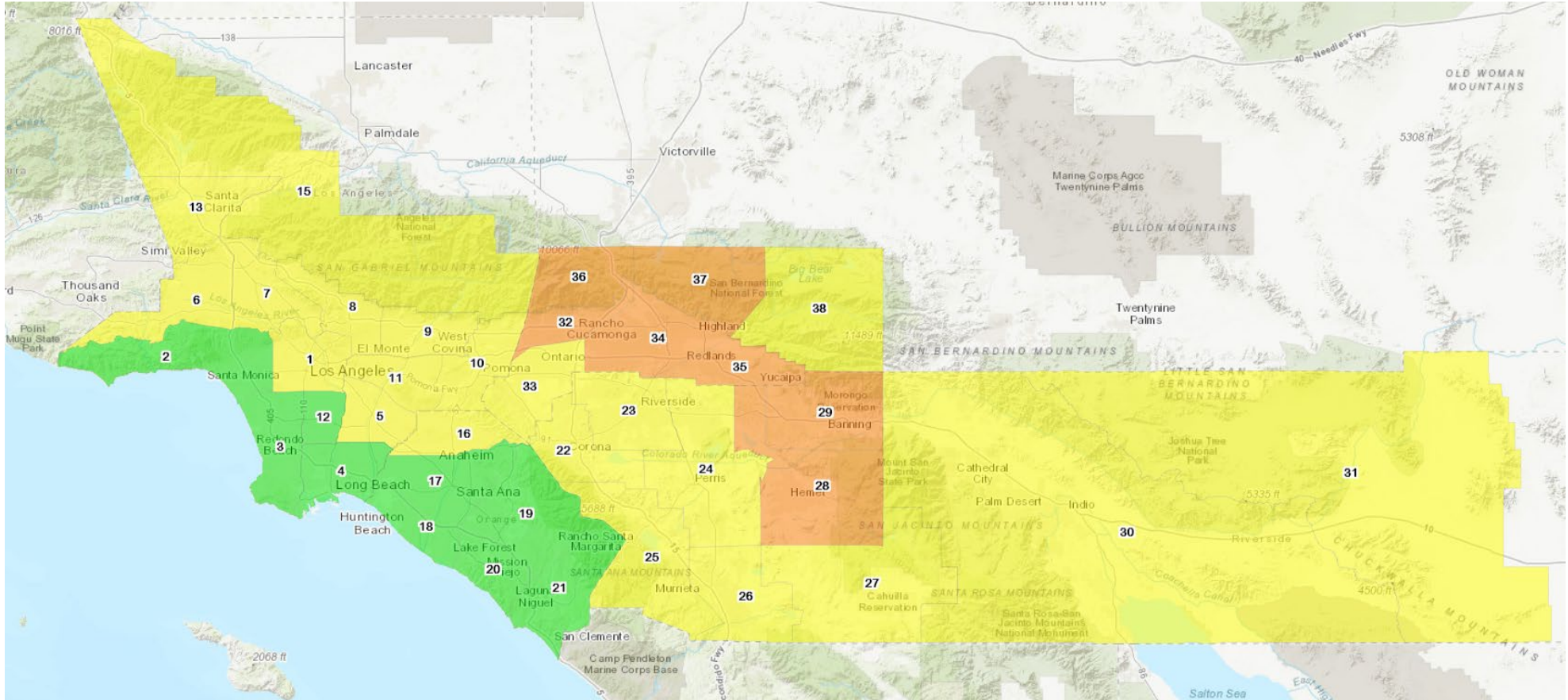

 - Unhealthy (151-200)
 - Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (101-150)
 - Moderate (51-100)
 - Good (0-50)
